into conciliation prior to a finding of
probable cause to believe.
4. In RAD Referral 98L-1A find reason to
believe that Tenet Healthcare Corporation
Political Action Committee and Susan Limon,
as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 432(b)(2)(B),
and enter into conciliation prior to a finding
of probable cause to believe.

In RAD Referral 98L-1B, find reason to believe that the Federation of American Health Systems Political Action Committee and Sylvia Ulrich, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b(a), and enter into conciliation prior to a finding of probable cause to believe.
6. Approve the Factual and Legal Analyses, proposed conciliation agreements, and the appropriate letters as recommended in the General Counsel's March 16, 1999 report
