GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT #2

I. ACTION RECOMMENDED

Accept the attached proposed conciliation agreement submitted by Citizens for the Republic and Angela Buchanan, as treasurer.

II. BACKGROUND

On January 10, 2001, the Commission found reason to believe that Citizens for the Republic and Carolyn Robertson, as treasurer (the "Respondents"), violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(4)(A)(i). The Commission also voted to enter into preprobable cause conciliation with the Respondents. Attached for the Commission's review is a signed counterproposal to the conciliation agreement approved by the Commission in settlement of this matter.¹ See Attachment 1. A check for the civil penalty has been received. See Attachment 2. This Office recommends that the Commission accept the counterproposal.

III. DISCUSSION OF CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

¹ During the course of this investigation, Carolyn Robertson is referenced throughout the First General Counsel's Report, Conciliation Agreement and Factual and Legal Analysis as treasurer. However, on February 22, 2001, Citizens for the Republic submitted a statement of organization naming Angela Buchanan as its new treasurer, and Ms. Buchanan has signed the conciliation agreement. Since a check for the full amount of the civil penalty has been received, this Office recommends that the Commission accept the signed conciliation agreement by Angela Buchanan and not reopen the investigation as it relates to Carolyn Robertson, the previous treasurer.

IV. RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Accept the attached conciliation agreement submitted by Citizens for the Republic and Angela Buchanan, as treasurer.
2. Close the file.
3. Approve the appropriate letter.
