Dear Mr. Herge:

On November 21, 2002, the Federal Election Commission notified your above-noted clients of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act").

On June 30, 2004, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, and information provided by you, that there is no reason to believe Roger Barrus, W.R. Bradley, Lavar Christensen, Fonda L. Eastman, Corby Facer, Jillyn Facer, Rebecca Facer, Tyson Facer, James R. Fraser, Sharon E. Fraser, Victor Iverson, Mandi Robinson, Timothy V. Stay or Robert Whitman violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(1)(A). In addition, the Commission found that there is no reason to believe Britta Lynn Facer or Riley Todd Facer violated the Act. Finally, the Commission dismissed the complaint with respect to Brent Facer. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter as it pertains to your clients.


