Dear Mr. Norton:

As you know, Congress recently added new requirements for disclaimers in television communications paid for by candidates or authorized by candidates [2 U.S.C. 441d(d)(1)]. I am writing to apprise the Commission of certain campaign acts which violate our campaign finance law. Stephanie Summers O'Neal for US Congress (Committee ID: C00395863) is the committee in question. The following outline provides detailed violations of our campaign finance laws:


1. The Committee began running television ads on or about January 7, 2004.

1.1.1. These ads do not satisfy the new statutory language requiring that a communication that is paid for or authorized by a candidate or the candidate's authorized committee and transmitted through television have an oral disclaimer spoken by the candidate himself or herself [2 U.S.C. 441d(d)(1)(B)].

1.1.2. These ads, which ran in the Jackson-metro area, are not consistent with FEC rules.

The Committee has clearly violated the letter and spirit of our campaign finance and election laws. I trust that a prompt and full investigation into these charges is forthcoming. If additional information is needed, please contact me.
