On October 20, 2004, your clients were notified that the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that they violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 434, 441a(f) and 441b(a), provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, and 11 CFR §§ 102.5, 104.10, 106.1 and 106.6. After considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on November 7, 2007, to take no further action as to Joint Victory Campaign 2004 and Janice Enright, in her official capacity as treasurer. Subsequently, the Commission closed the file in this matter on November 16, 2007.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003).
