

**SECOND CONSENT TO EXTEND TIME
 TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT SUIT**

The Missouri Republican State Committee—Federal Committee and Harvey M. Tottlebaum as treasurer (collectively, "Respondents") and the Commission wish to extend pre-probable cause conciliation discussions in this matter for an additional fifteen days. Respondents agree to toll the statute of limitations for a period of fifteen days for any civil enforcement action that the Commission might institute concerning MUR 5447 pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(6). Combined with the prior tolling agreement signed by Respondents, this agreement thereby extends the time in which the Commission may institute a civil law enforcement suit for forty-five (45) calendar days from the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462 and/or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in this matter. There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit without the written consent of Respondents.
