On October 21, 2004, the Federal Election Commission ("Commission") notified Keyes 2004, Inc. and Eugene T. Carter, in his official capacity as Treasurer, ("Committee") of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On December 8, 2005, the Commission notified the Committee that the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint that there is no reason to believe that the Committee violated the Act. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter as it pertained to the Committee, but the file remained open with respect to the other respondents. This is to advise you that the entire file in this matter has been closed, and this matter is now public. Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003). Please find enclosed a copy of the dispositive General Counsel's Report.
