On behalf of Friends of Lauzen (the "Respondent"), this letter responds to the correspondence dated April 3, 2006 from the Federal Elections Commission (the "Commission") regarding a complaint dated March 17, 2006 (the "Complaint") filed by Lisa Pierce (the "Complainant").

Respondent is a state political committee formed pursuant to the Illinois Campaign Disclosure Act for the purpose of electing State Senator Chris Lauzen ("Lauzen") to the Illinois State Senate.

Based on the material set forth below, the Respondent respectfully requests that the Commission find no reason to believe that the facts alleged in the Complaint pose a violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act") or its implementing regulations and that this matter be dismissed and that the Commission take no further action.

I. TRANSMISSION OF MASS ELECTRONIC MAIL MESSAGE

The Complaint alleges that on January 17, 2006, Complainant received a mass electronic email message generated from a website maintained by the Respondent. Among other identifying features, this email message indicated it was sent from "Lauzen for Congress". See Complainant's Exhibit C.

The Respondent acknowledges that the email was sent, but strongly disagrees with the Complainant's assertion that the inadvertent inclusion of the display name "Lauzen for

Congress” by the vendor that sent it requires the Respondent to register with the Commission as a federal campaign committee.

A. Mass Email Transmission Inadvertently Contained Wrong Display Name

The mass email cited in the Complaint was generated by Integrated Web Strategy, a firm located in Phoenix, Arizona that was engaged by the Respondent to provide web hosting and other electronic communications services.

Attached as Respondent’s Exhibit A is a letter signed by Max Fose, owner of Integrated Web Strategy. Mr. Fose’s letter states that the display name in the email transmission inadvertently contained the name “Lauzen for Congress” when it should have stated that the message was transmitted by “Friends for Lauzen”, the correct name of the Respondent. Moreover, the letter from Mr. Fose unequivocally states that the Respondent did not engage Integrated Web Strategy with the intention of becoming a candidate for Congress.

B. Email Error Was Quickly Corrected

The first mass email generated by Integrated Web Strategy on behalf of the Respondent bears a time stamp showing that it was sent on January 17, 2006 at 1:58 p.m.

It is erroneously stated by the Complainant that the corrected email was sent out the next day. In fact, the time stamp of the corrected email attached as Exhibit D to the Complaint clearly shows that the corrected email was sent out on the same day, January 17, 2006, at 3:28 p.m., a mere 90 minutes after the original email

Respondent was among the first recipients of the mass email to notice the error and took quick action to correct it by causing Integrated Web Strategy to send the second email with an explanation that the display name of the first transmission contained an error and a statement that Lauzen was a candidate for reelection to the State Senate.

C. Email Clearly Sent Solely In Connection With State Campaign Activities

Except for the inadvertent error in the display name, all of the banners, headings and content of the original email transmission support Respondent’s position that it was sent by a lawfully formed state campaign committee solely in connection with Respondent’s state campaign activities.

The opinion piece contained in the email is a critical analysis of the capital budget of the State of Illinois and an upcoming State of the State speech to the Illinois General Assembly by Governor Rod Blagojevich. As a sitting member of the Illinois General Assembly and announced candidate for reelection, State Senator Lauzen would be expected to comment on these important matters. The commentary does not contain a single reference to federal political activities or advance or propose a federal candidacy for Lauzen.

D. Lauzen Was a Declared Candidate for Reelection for State Senate

Pursuant to the election calendar promulgated by the Illinois State Board of Election (the "ISBE"), candidates seeking nomination or election in the 2006 primary and general election could circulate nominating petitions for signature during the time period between September 20, 2005 and December 19, 2005.

In anticipation of Lauzen's reelection campaign in 2006, on October 5, 2005 the Respondent caused to be prepared and mailed the letter attached as Respondent's Exhibit B. The letter was sent to precinct committeeman and supporters in Lauzen's State Senate district to urge them to circulate a petition in support of Lauzen's upcoming reelection campaign.

The nominating petitions filed by the Respondent with the ISBE show that many of the signatures submitted on behalf of Lauzen were gathered as early in the petition circulating period as October 12-18, 2005. See copies of Respondent's nominating petitions attached as Respondent's Exhibit C.

On December 21, 2005, almost a month before the email was sent out, the Respondent sent out a press release announcing Lauzen's reelection campaign and launch of the new campaign website. See Respondent's Exhibit D.

Therefore, by the time the email was transmitted on January 17, 2006, Lauzen's intent to seek reelection was well known in the community and had been formalized with the ISBE. Attached as Respondent's Exhibit E is a receipt issued on December 19, 2005 by the ISBE acknowledging the filing of all the required documents to establish Lauzen as a candidate for reelection as a State Senator

E. Transmission of Email Does Not Require Registration with the Commission

The well documented facts set forth above clearly demonstrate that the transmission of the email with the wrong display name was an inadvertent error caused by a vendor, not the Respondent directly. Moreover, when the error was detected, the Respondent acted within 90 minutes to correct it by sending out another email the very same afternoon with the correct display name.

In addition, it was a well known fact that on the date the email was sent, Lauzen was an announced candidate for reelection. Other than Complainant's selective, and in most instances erroneous, reading of the text of the email, there is no possibility that there was any likelihood of confusion that the Respondent was the source of the email and that it was sent as part of Respondent's state campaign activities.

II. POLL

In the Complaint, the Complainant references a poll that several friends had been called to participate in and in underlined text states "It is my understanding that exploratory polls for a congressional seat can not be paid for from a state campaign account."

The Respondent acknowledges that during the period of time from November 8-10, 2005 it conducted a poll of Republican voters in Illinois 14th Congressional District. Among other topics covered in the poll, voters were asked their candidate preference if Speaker Hastert retired from Congress and the 14th District were an "open seat" for the 2008 election cycle. As noted in the Complaint, voters were asked other questions on other topics as well, including whether the State of Illinois was on the right track/wrong track, their views on various policy issues and questions on overall name recognition of prominent Republican politicians from the area, including Lauzen.

For the purpose of responding to the vague legal conclusions set forth in the Complaint, the Respondent will assume that the Complainant is alleging that at the time the poll was conducted, Lauzen was "testing the waters" for federal office and that the FEC should use scarce enforcement resources to take action against the Respondent for using funds from a state political committee to conduct the poll.

A. Brief Summary of Relevant Authority

The Commission accurately stated the controlling law and regulations in this area when it wrote:

An individual becomes a candidate for federal office - and thus triggers registration and reporting under the Act - when campaign activity exceeds \$5,000 in either contributions or expenditures. However, money raised and spent solely to "test the waters" does not count toward this dollar threshold until the individual decides to run for federal office or conducts activities that indicate he or she has decided to become a candidate. (MUR 4759) (Statement of Reasons-Maloof).

Under the "testing the waters" exemption set forth in Commission regulations, payments made solely for the purpose of determining whether an individual should become a candidate are not "expenditures" under the Act. The regulations go on to say that a payment made to conduct a poll to determine if an individual should become a candidate is one of the examples of "testing the waters" activity. Finally, only funds that are in compliance with the limit and source restrictions of the Act may be used for "testing the waters" activity. 11 CFR 100.131(a).

B. Respondent Was Not Testing the Waters

On the dates the poll was conducted, it is obvious that Lauzen was not a "candidate" for federal office as that term is defined in the Act and regulations. The issue here is whether simply conducting the poll compels the conclusion that the Respondent was "testing the waters" for federal office. Respondent asserts that it does not.

In issuing the Explanation and Justification to the 1985 revision to the "testing the waters" exemption, the Commission stated that "the determination of whether an individual has

crossed the line from testing the waters to campaigning must be made on a case by case basis". 50 Fed. Reg. 9993 (1985).

If the determination of "candidate" status is made by reviewing the facts of each individual case, then surely the issue of whether an individual or state campaign committee was "testing the waters" must also involve the same type of careful review of the unique facts and circumstances of each case. In fact, the language of the regulation invites such factual analysis by stating that "examples" of activity permitted under the "testing the waters" exemption "include but are not limited to, conducting a poll, telephone calls and travel." 11 C.F.R. 100.131(b). By providing examples, and not an exhaustive list, of the type of activities that qualify under the exemption, it is clear that the facts of each case should guide the determination of whether an individual is indeed "testing the waters".

A review of the facts in the Complaint unmistakably demonstrates that there was no "testing the waters" for a federal election and that the expenditure of state committee funds by the Respondent for the poll did not violate the Act or regulations.

First, as Respondent has clearly established above, as early as October 5, 2005 when it sent out nominating petitions for circulation and signature, it was the publicly stated intention of Lauzen to seek reelection to the State Senate. From that time until the present, the Respondent has continued to expend resources solely in pursuit of that goal. Furthermore, the Respondent's only efforts to get Lauzen on the ballot for the 2006 primary and general election were for reelection to the State Senate.

Second, the newspaper article about the poll attached as Exhibit B to the Complaint accurately characterizes the political reality that the 14th District is currently represented very ably by Speaker Hastert and it might be some time before the district is considered an "open seat" when Lauzen or any other prospective successor might have a chance to stand for election to the seat.

In reviewing Advisory Opinions and other matters where the Commission was called on to review whether an individual was a "candidate" or merely "testing the waters", the available precedent shows that the Commission looks to the regulations now set forth at C.F.R. 100.131(b) to determine whether, among other factors, a state committee or individual conducted campaign activities "in close proximity" to the election. (See for example MUR 4759). In most of these types of cases, the state committee or individual in question ultimately went from "testing the waters" to declaring a formal candidacy in the then current election cycle.

In contrast, Lauzen is obviously not a candidate for federal office in the current election cycle. From the commencement of the petition circulation period in Illinois for the 2006 elections, Respondent's only expressed intent was to reelect Lauzen to the State Senate.

In this case, the facts demonstrate with great clarity that Respondent's activity for the 2005-2006 election cycle has been exclusively in support of Lauzen's reelection to the State Senate. The Complainant's unsupported inference that the Respondent was "testing the waters" is flawed and contrary to the letter and spirit of the Commission's regulations and precedent in

this area which generally hold that activity must be in close proximity to an election for the activity to be deemed for the purpose of "testing the waters" or campaigning for federal office.

C. Other Purposes of the Poll

While one purpose of the poll was to gauge voter preferences in a hypothetical congressional election that may or may not occur at some point in the distant future, the Respondent had other purposes for conducting the poll.

On February 18, 2005 Lauzen introduced SB 600, legislation that would amend Illinois law to permit the direct election of State Central Committeeman in each of Illinois congressional district by primary voters. Under current law, State Central Committeemen are selected by local party officials. A copy of the bill status for SB 600 is attached as Respondent's Exhibit F.

SB 600 passed the Illinois State Senate on a unanimous vote on April 14, 2005. As SB 600 was sent to the Illinois House of Representatives for consideration, Lauzen was being urged by his supporters to run for State Central Committeeman from the 14th District.

Since it was introduced, SB 600 has been a source of controversy and the issue of direct election of State Central Committeeman has bitterly divided the Illinois Republican Party. While obviously Lauzen played a leading role in SB 600 passing the State Senate and supports its enactment, he understandably wanted to measure his name identification and popularity among rank and file party members in the 14th District before becoming more directly involved in this highly charged issue and undertaking to run for State Central Committeeman if SB 600 became law.

In addition, in the 1998 general election Lauzen was the Republican nominee for Comptroller of the State of Illinois. Since that time he has enjoyed a higher profile than he had prior to the statewide race, but this increased stature has also made him the target of increased criticism from his local political opponents. A benchmark poll like the one conducted by last November allows the Respondent to determine if Lauzen still maintains increased name identification and popularity from the statewide race and effectively plan fundraising and other political strategy based on the poll results.

D. Funds Were From Permitted Sources

Illinois law allows state campaign committees to receive unlimited campaign contributions from individuals, as well as corporate and labor unions. Respondent acknowledges that it has received campaign contributions from corporations as permitted under Illinois law.

But even if the Commission were to reach the unlikely conclusion that the Respondent had engaged in "testing the waters" activity to determine if Lauzen should become a candidate for federal election at some unspecified time, the documents attached hereto as Respondent's Exhibit G make evident that the Respondent has received what would be termed "hard money" contributions under the Act in amounts more than sufficient to cover the \$12,750 cost of the poll.

During the period from January 1, 2005 until its last filing with the ISBE on March 19, 2006, the Respondent received \$117,886 in total contributions from all sources. Of this total

amount, \$85,326 or 72% of all contributions received were "hard money" or from sources permitted under the Act and in accordance with the "testing the waters" exemption.

The documents filed with the ISBE attached as Respondent's Exhibit H show that during this time period, Respondent maintained a balance of cash on hand in its state campaign committee account between \$29,375.32 and \$79,173.95.

III. CONCLUSION

The Commission should affirmatively find no reason to believe the Respondent violated the Act and specifically the "testing the waters" regulation set forth at 11 C.F.R 100.131 because (i) the email cited in the Complaint was an inadvertent vendor error that was quickly remedied and occurred well after Lauzen became a candidate for reelection to the State Senate for the 2006 election; and (ii) the facts show that the Respondent was not "testing the waters" for a federal office and was only engaged in state campaign activity (e.g. circulating nominating petitions for State Senate, filing state nominating papers with the ISBE) when the poll was conducted; and (iii) even if Respondent had been "testing the waters", it paid for the poll with funds raised within the limit and source restrictions contained in the Act.

In submitting this material to the Commission, the Respondent does not waive any of its rights that any future action on this matter will be kept confidential pursuant to relevant Commission regulations and respectfully reiterates its request that this matter be dismissed and that the Commission take no further action
