Re: Complaint against Jack Davis, Save Jobs Party and Save American Jobs

Dear Sir or Madam:

We respectfully file this complaint against Jack Davis' "Save Jobs Party" federal 527 group, the "Save American Jobs" New York state political action committee, and against Jack Davis as an individual, specifically concerning the ongoing pattern of unlawful activity by Davis and his sham groups and obvious campaign activity.

Since losing in his run for Congress in 2004 (which resulted in fines paid to the Federal Election Commission), Jack Davis has continued to campaign, self-promote and attack opponents. This continued campaign activity – achieved through various non-profit entities and conducted without the usual financial disclosure – has already been questioned. This complaint sets forth additional activities by Davis that are unlawful, particularly in light of the Federal Election Commission's recent rulemaking concerning the political committee status of so-called 527 groups of the sort set up by Davis.

Further, Davis' constant weaving of federal and state entities, and violations of applicable state and federal law, mandate that this complaint be made simultaneously with both the Federal Elections Commission and the New York State Board of Elections. Violations include the following:

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## **I. Violations of Federal Law**

### **1. Excessive contributions by Jack Davis**

The October Quarterly report filed by Davis for his Save Jobs Party reveals several excessive contributions. In fact, the Commission's Reports Analysis Division has already questioned these contributions. *See* Exhibit A (attached hereto).

At issue are excessive contributions made by Davis himself – he gave \$10,000 on August 12, and \$10,000 on September 28 of last year. Of course, given that the Save Jobs Party is actually a non-connected political committee (established by Davis' own reports filed with the Commission), the limitation on such contributions is \$5,000 per year. Thus, Davis has made a \$15,000 excessive contribution to his Save Jobs Party.

We ask that the Commission (1) require that the Save Jobs Party refund the excessive contributions; (2) impose a fine against the Save Jobs Party and its treasurer Jack Davis; and (3) enjoin Davis from further violations of Federal election law.

### **2. Failure to report in-kinds/prohibited contributions**

The Save Jobs Party has had a handful of events, but has failed to show any expenditures made in connection with those events. For example, the Save Jobs Party had a fundraiser on June 21, 2005. *See* Exhibit B (attached hereto). Although Davis itemized contributions that presumably were received at this fundraiser, there are no expenses listed. This is all the more remarkable given that the fundraiser was held at Marianaccio's Restaurant.

Perhaps Davis failed to disclose fundraising costs and other overhead expenses made in connection with this event. This is not unlike a recent Commission enforcement matter against a committee affiliated with Senator Clinton. MUR 5225 (Respondent New York Senate 2000, et al). In that matter, Clinton's joint-fundraising committee failed to report expenses made in connection with a fundraising event, which resulted in a \$35,000 fine.

Or, perhaps Davis simply took things or services for free, and failed to report the value of such in-kind contributions. This is particularly troubling, as the event was held at Marianaccio's Restaurant. If the restaurant is incorporated (which is common, if for no other reason than liability purposes), Davis and his sham committee accepted a prohibited corporate contribution. 2 U.S.C. § 441(b).

Moreover, it is not at all clear that the contributions that were reported in connection with this event came from permissible funds. In fact, it is likely that the funds are prohibited soft money, as each of the nine contributions came from entities that accept soft money.

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Finally, it appears as though Davis' Save Jobs Party is receiving corporate support from Davis' for-profit enterprise. Recently, the Commission has imposed significant penalties for such use of corporate resources. MUR 5020 (Respondent Gormley for Senate Primary Election Fund, et al., total civil penalty of \$115,000) and MUR 5573 (Respondent Westar Energy, Inc., et al; total civil penalty of \$40,500). Here, both Davis' Save Jobs Party, and his Save American Jobs NYS PAC list their address as 12600 Clarence Center Road in Akron, New York. The obvious issue is the benefit received by the Save Jobs Party from the soft money shadow group Save American Jobs. But critically, 12600 Clarence Center Road is also the address used by Davis' for-profit enterprise. [11 CFR 114.9].

We ask that the Commission (1) determine whether or not Davis took prohibited money, and if so, impose a fine; (2) impose a fine for his failure to report his activities; (3) require him to amend his reports to ensure the accuracy of the public record; and (4) enjoin him from use of soft money for federal election activity.

### **3. Vague descriptions of spending activity**

In addition to his reporting problems outlined above, Davis has described certain expenditures in murky terms. This frustrates the central purpose of the Federal Election Campaign Act – public disclosure. The Commission has promulgated regulations that provide guidance as to what is an acceptable description, and what is not. 11 C.F.R. 104.3(b)(3).

In particular, Davis' recent report lists such vagaries as "prof services rendered," "consultant fees," and "services rendered." These are not sufficient descriptions under section 104 of the Commission's regulations. Not surprisingly, the Commission's Reports Analysis Division has already questioned these descriptions, and instructed Davis to amend his reports to correct his shortcomings.

We ask that the Commission (1) require Davis to amend his reports to ensure a full and accurate public record, and (2) impose a fine for Davis' failure to describe his activities with sufficient clarity.

### **4. Use of soft money for federal elections**

Recently, in response to activities of shadowy so-called "527" committees, the Commission promulgated new regulations designed to require such groups, in the event they participate in the federal election process, to register, report and abide by federal election law. In paying for overhead, at least 50% of such committee expenditures must come from so-called hard money. How a particular committee makes such expenditures is revealed on its FEC reports, which require the disclosure of such shared federal/non-federal activity.

Davis has really made a mess of this rule. His reports reveal no shared federal/non-federal activity, which upon review of his reports, activities and statements, cannot be true. Generally, when a committee fails to disclose any joint activity, it would mean that the committee is an entirely federal committee. But here, Davis himself (both through actions and words) has said that is not the case. For example, his reports reveal various soft money contributions, such as \$500 from the UAW and \$50 from the Buffalo PBA. He also received several contributions from non-federal, state and local candidates. So, obviously, in light of this raising of soft money, he cannot possibly have no joint federal/non-federal activity.

Critically, Davis has already attempted to tell the Commission that the Save Jobs Party is really a non-federal committee, and that no expenditures were, in Davis' words, "used to influence a Federal election." This is not true. According to a March 2, 2005 Roll Call article, Davis had traveled to Washington to meet with DCCC Chairman Rahm Emanuel and New York U.S. Representative Louise Slaughter, to discuss his possible run for Congress. In fact, the article reported that Davis said he was "running again" (Davis ran and lost in 2004), and that he said "when I run again" – obviously, Davis has been engaging in activity in connection with a federal election for some time.

Likewise, his Save American Jobs PAC (a non-federal PAC filed with the New York State Board of Elections) – which, as discussed below in more detail, appears to be the affiliated alter-ego of the Save Jobs Party – has made a number of expenditures that appear on their face to be designed to influence a federal election. *See Exhibit C (attached hereto)*. Included on this list are both travel to Washington, DC and lodging in the DC area (coupled with news accounts of his visits to Democratic Party headquarters, this leads to only one conclusion); subscriptions to publications that cover federal elections, car rentals in the Washington, DC area (which, if not made for some sort of federal election purpose, could very well constitute prohibited personal use of campaign funds); and attendance at a campaign school, the Leadership Institute.

We ask that the Commission (1) fully investigate the activities of Jack Davis; (2) impose significant penalties for what appears to be a knowing and willful violation of the Commission's rules on political committee status; and (3) require that Davis terminate his Save Jobs Party, and any other affiliated entities.

## **5. Affiliation**

Davis' ever-changing web of shadow entities and his obvious campaign for federal office point to the conclusion that all of his entities are affiliated. This is significant because affiliated entities share a common contribution limit; therefore, Davis' efforts to spend his own money, while at the same time obscuring from public view other spending, ought to be subject to a common federal limit.

Committees are affiliated if they are established, maintained, controlled or financed by the same person or persons. Affiliation is easily established here – use of the same addresses, Davis' service as treasurer and control over the entities, his use of his own money to significantly finance his various sham committees – the list goes on and on, and all point to one and only one conclusion: that Davis has established a number of affiliated entities.

If past Commission action is any guide, the penalty for such antics can be severe. For example, in MUR 5328 (Respondent PAC to the Future, et al), the Commission found that Representative Pelosi had established several non-connected committees. The result was a \$21,000 penalty, and the termination of the offending committee.

We ask that the Commission (1) find that Davis, his fledging campaign for Congress, his Save Jobs Party and his Save American Jobs PAC are affiliated; (2) require Davis to refund any and all excessive contributions; (3) require that Davis terminate the offending committees; and (4) impose a monetary penalty.

#### **6. Failure to file and use of prohibited corporate funds.**

Chapter 14, Section 431 (2) (a) states that an individual becomes a candidate for federal office “if such individual has received contributions aggregating in excess of \$5,000 or has made expenditures in excess of \$5,000.” Meeting this threshold triggers mandatory reporting requirements.

On December 1, 2005, Jack Davis registered the “Jack Davis Exploratory Committee, Inc.” with the State of New York as a Domestic-Not-For-Profit Corporation. The stated purpose of “Jack Davis Exploratory Committee, Inc.” is to assist Davis “as he tests the waters for another run for Congress.” Acting as agent for Davis was the law firm of Duke, Holzman, Yeager and Photiadis, LLP, for which it is reasonable to assume a fee was charged.

On January 4, 2006, Davis registered the web domains jackdavis.org and jackdavisexploratorycommittee.com, representing yet another expenditure of funds. Davis again expended funds on March 14, 2006, registering jackdavisforcongress.us.

On February 7, 2006, The Buffalo News reported that Davis' activities include “hiring high-level political consultants, including pollster Stan Greenberg, who worked on President Bill Clinton's campaigns, and Hank Sheinkopf of New York City, one of the top Democratic consultants in the state.” A week later, on February 12, 2006, The Buffalo News reported “add Jim Spencer, a well-known Boston direct mail consultant, to the list of heavy hitters that Akron industrialist Jack Davis has compiled for his expected campaign...” Davis' hiring of Spencer and his company, Campaign Network, was further reported by National Journal's “Hotline,” a Washington, DC-based publication. *See Exhibit D (attached hereto).*

Finally, and most recently, on March 27, 2006, the "Jack Davis Exploratory Committee, Inc." announced that it had conducted a poll regarding Davis' candidacy. Ironically, the e-mail carries the disclaimer "Paid for by Davis for Congress." The only such committee reporting with the Federal Elections Commission under that name is associated with U.S. Representative Danny Davis of Illinois, and Representative Davis's FEC reports list no such expenditures on behalf of candidate Jack Davis of New York. Regardless, Davis' previous Congressional Committee, Jack Davis for Congress, last reported a cash on hand balance of \$0, and a debt of \$250,000. *See* Exhibit E (attached hereto).

Davis' latest sham enterprise, the Jack Davis Exploratory Committee, Inc., is troubling for many reasons and, not inconsistent with Davis' past transgressions, represents further violations of Federal Election Law.

First, though Davis has clearly expended funds – conducting legal work, purchasing web domains, hiring political consultants, and conducting a poll of New York's 26<sup>th</sup> Congressional district – no disclosures have been made.

Further, Davis' latest enterprise continues his web of affiliations using prohibited funds. Material posted to the website of the Jack Davis Exploratory Committee, Inc., (jackdavis.org and jackdavisexploratorycommittee.com) bear a striking resemblance in style and content to Davis' previous campaign website (jackdavisforcongress.com) and not-for-profit website (saveamericanjobs.us). In fact, documents, photos and materials are routinely duplicated and posted amongst the sham organizations *See* Exhibit F (attached hereto).

Further, the Jack Davis Exploratory Committee, Inc., - as has been the case with Davis' other enterprises - again violates federal law by using prohibited corporate funds to finance federal election activities. Jackdavis.org, jackdavisexploratorycommittee.com and jackdavisforcongress.us are all registered to the I Square R Element Company, Davis' for-profit corporate enterprise. *See* Exhibit G (attached hereto).

Most importantly, even if Davis somehow had set up a proper exploratory operation, his own disclaimer on his materials make clear he is a candidate. Use of the disclaimer "Davis for Congress" is express advocacy, and as a matter of law makes Davis a candidate. (See 11 CFR 100.72(b) and 11 CFR 100.131(b)). We ask that the Commission (1) determine whether or not Davis took prohibited money, and if so, impose a fine; (2) impose a fine for his failure to report his activities.

## **II. Violations of State Law**

### **1.) Failure to file disclosure reports.**

The Save American Jobs PAC is a political committee under New York law, registered with the New York State Board of Elections (NYS BOE). The PAC is closely associated with Jack Davis, as he is the sole contributor to the PAC and the PAC seemingly finances his political activities. *See* Exhibit H (attached hereto). The Save American Jobs PAC has not filed a disclosure report since on or about July 15, 2005. Depending upon the scope of the PAC's activity, as many as seven disclosure report filings could have been required by law. For example, as was reported in various media outlets, the Save American Jobs PAC was actively engaged in financing activities for a campaign in New York's September 13, 2005, primary, although no such activity has been reported. *See* Exhibit I (attached hereto).

Minimally, one report on January 15, 2006, was required. The NYS BOE has filed a lawsuit against the Save American Jobs PAC to compel a January 15, 2006 periodic disclosure report (see NYS BOE v. Matt Bova as Treasurer of Save American Jobs PAC, et.al. – Albany County Supreme Court: Index # 1048-06). We urge the NYS BOE to investigate all the activities of the Save American Jobs PAC to determine if they unlawfully failed to file other required disclosure reports.

### **2.) Jack Davis as an individual acting as a political committee. Failure to register as a political committee and file disclosure reports.**

In addition to political activities outlined in Exhibit I, Jack Davis financed political activities in various campaigns throughout Western New York in 2005. Specifically, Davis advocated the election of numerous individuals through a series of advertisements paid for by Jack Davis. *See* Exhibit J (attached hereto). These are the only examples we were able to locate, although others may exist.

For the advertisements located, none of the supported candidates reported in-kind contributions from Jack Davis. Additionally, the Save American Jobs PAC disclosed no expenditures for these advertisements.

Article 14 of the NYS Election Law governs campaign finance. Any entity acting as a political committee must register with the state as a political committee and periodically report its activities. Section 14-100 (1) defines political activity as follows:


- 1.) "political committee" means any corporation aiding or promoting and any committee, political club or combination of one or more persons operating or co-operating to aid or to promote the success or defeat of a political party or principle, or of any ballot proposal; or to aid or take part in the election or defeat of a candidate for public office or to aid or take part in the election or defeat of a candidate for nomination at a primary election or convention, including all proceedings prior to such primary election, or of a candidate for any party position voted for at a primary election, or to aid or defeat the nomination by petition of an independent candidate for public office.

Consequently, an individual making expenditures in support or opposition to candidates triggers political committee status unless those expenditures are reported as in-kind contributions by the benefiting candidates. Since none of these expenditures were reported as contributions by the benefiting candidates, Jack Davis was required by law to register as a political committee and fully disclose all of his political activities.

We respectfully request that the NYS BOE commence a lawsuit compelling Jack Davis to register as a political committee and fully disclose his political activities, and to seek civil penalties as appropriate pursuant to Section 14-126 (1) of the New York State Election Law.



Dear Mr. Davis:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above. An itemization of the information needed follows:

-Schedule A of your report (see attached) discloses one or more contributions which appear to exceed the limits set forth in the Act. 2 U.S.C. §441a(f) and 11 CFR §§110.1(d) and 110.2(d) prohibit a committee and its affiliates from receiving any contribution from another political committee or person in excess of \$5,000 per calendar year.

If any apparently excessive contribution in question was incompletely or incorrectly disclosed, you must amend your original report with the clarifying information.

If any contribution you received exceeds the limits, you may have to refund the excessive amount. The funds can be retained if within 60 days of receipt, (1) the excessive amount was properly reattributed to another person, such as a joint account holder, by obtaining signed written authorizations from each person making the contribution pursuant to 11 CFR 110.1(k)(3), and (2) the treasurer informs the person making the contribution that he or she may request the return of the excessive portion of the contribution if it is not intended to be a joint contribution. Any request from a donor for a refund must be honored.

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Alternatively, the funds can be retained if within 60 days of receipt you (1) transferred the excessive amount to an account not used to influence federal elections, and (2) provided written notice to the person making the contribution of the option of receiving a refund. Any request from a donor for a refund must be honored.

If the foregoing conditions for reattributions or transfers to a non-federal account were not met within 60 days of receipt, the excessive amount must be refunded.

Please inform the Commission of your corrective action immediately in writing and provide a photocopy of your check for any transfer-out or refund. In addition, any reattributions should be reported as memo entries on Schedule A of the report covering the period during which the authorization for the reattribution is received. Any transfers-out or refunds should be disclosed on Schedule B supporting Line 22 or 28 of the report during which the transaction was made.

Although the Commission may take further legal action regarding the acceptance of an excessive contribution(s), prompt action by your committee to seek reattribution, transfer-out or refund the excessive amount will be taken into consideration.

-Itemized disbursements must include a brief statement or description of why the disbursements were made. Please amend Schedule B supporting Line 21(b) of your report to clarify the following descriptions: "prof services rendered," "consultant fees," and "services rendered." For further guidance regarding acceptable purposes of disbursements, please refer to 11 CFR §104.3(b)(3).

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered. Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended. 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Democrat Jack Davis is assembling a top-level campaign team for the area's premier congressional race this year as he prepares for a repeat challenge to Republican powerhouse Thomas M. Reynolds of Clarence.

Davis, president of an Akron heating element manufacturer, is weeks away from officially announcing his candidacy. But all signs point to another run against Reynolds, built once again upon his anti-free trade views. He also appears ready to match the \$1.2 million he committed to his unsuccessful 2004 race.

"Maybe more," he said of his spending plans for this year.

Davis would not elaborate further on his plans during a recent interview, but sources close to him and local Democratic officials point to evidence of serious campaign preparations, including:

- \* Phone calls to Davis encouraging his candidacy from Rep. Rahm Emmanuel of Illinois, head of the Democratic Congressional Campaign Committee, which is charged with electing more Democrats to the House of Representatives.

- \* Hiring high-level political consultants, including pollster Stan Greenberg, who worked on former President Bill Clinton's campaigns, and Hank Sheinkopf of New York City, one of the top Democratic consultants in the state.

- \* Davis' reaching out to local and national Democrats for more staff help and coordination than in 2004.

National Democrats are intrigued by a Davis candidacy because of his ability to self-finance his campaign and, at the very least, tie down Reynolds, chairman of the Republican National Congressional Committee. Democrats are making an issue of the war in Iraq and scandals dragging down Reynolds allies, including former House Majority Leader Tom DeLay of Texas. They believe they can overcome Reynolds' 56 to 44 percent ratio of victory over Davis in 2004.

Bill Burton, a Buffalo native and Democratic campaign committee spokesman, called Reynolds a "good guy who has made bad choices," citing his vote for the Central American Free Trade Agreement.

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"Being from Western New York, I know [the North American Free Trade Agreement] decimated a lot of industries in town, so for Tom Reynolds to vote for another trade agreement is not what the folks in Western New York sent him to Congress to do," he said. "Jobs are what's the priority for Western New York."

But knocking off Reynolds, one of the top Republicans in the House, will not prove an easy assignment. His latest filing with the Federal Elections Commission indicates he has \$2.4 million on hand, plus \$936,000 in his own political action committee. In addition, he is bolstered by a carefully drawn congressional district in which Republicans outnumber Democrats 186,000 to 142,000.

Reynolds spokesman L.D. Platt called the budding Davis candidacy "old news."

"He's been doing this for however long he's been doing this, so it's old news," Platt said of Davis.

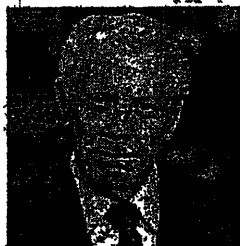

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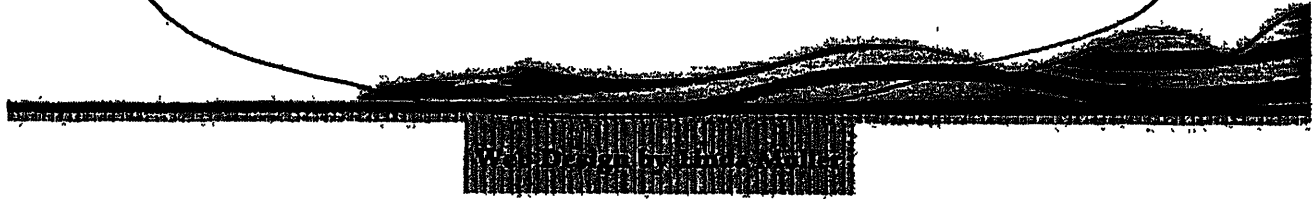

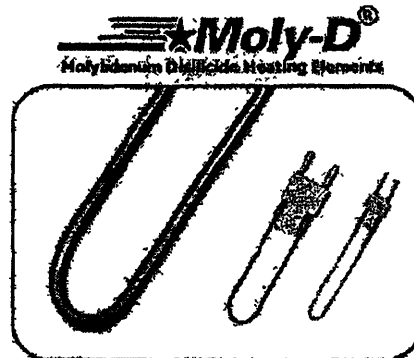

## Ranzenhofer seeks probe over calls to voters

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A "celebrity voice impression" of County Executive Joel A. Giambra phoned to Clarence-area voters over the weekend has prompted Legislator Michael H. Ranzenhofer to seek a criminal investigation by the FBI.

Ranzenhofer complained to reporters in County Hall this morning that calls allegedly placed by Giambra identifying Ranzenhofer as his candidate are "deceptive and fraudulent."

He said the calls were traced by caller ID to the Akron headquarters of Save American Jobs, a political action committee headed by industrialist Jack Davis.

Though both Ranzenhofer and Giambra are Republicans, the county executive has fallen to all time lows in the polls, prompting Ranzenhofer to bristle at the alleged Giambra connection. He played the tape for reporters today, revealing a supposed Giambra endorsement indicating "Erie County would not be in the shape it is today without Mike Ranzenhofer."

Davis spokesman Curtis Ellis acknowledged the calls originated from the Save American Jobs office on behalf of John Schrock, who is opposing Ranzenhofer in Tuesday's Republican primary and is the endorsed Democratic candidate in the general election. He declined to comment when asked if his voice was heard on the tape, but said the calls were placed after Ranzenhofer mailed fliers throughout the district claiming Schrock was supported by Democrats and Legislature Chairman George A. Holt Jr.

Ellis disputed Ranzenhofer's claims that Schrock was "handpicked" by Democratic officials. He added he had no knowledge of Ranzenhofer's contention that Schrock's designating petitions were circulated by Democratic staffers in the County Legislature. Ellis also pointed out the messages contain a "clear disclaimer" at their end indicating they constitute a celebrity impersonation. But Ranzenhofer played a tape demonstrating that the disclaimer was read "very, very quickly," adding many of his constituents believe the message stemmed from Giambra.

Would you know the voice of Joel Giambra if he called you? Republican primary election candidate Michael Ranzenhofer wants an investigation into what he calls possible wire and identity fraud because of a campaign phone call.

"This, I believe, is criminal impersonation, fraudulent, deceptive," he said at a news conference on the steps of Erie County Hall on Monday. Ranzenhofer is talking about a phone call to Republican voters in his Clarence-based 4th Legislative District.

The call begins, "This is Joel Giambra calling on behalf of attorney Mike Ranzenhofer. Erie County would not be where it is today without Mike Ranzenhofer. On Tuesday, you can be sure that a vote for attorney Mike Ranzenhofer is a vote for the Giambra agenda."

Ranzenhofer said, "What I've done is contact the FBI and the US Attorney and asked that they investigate this."

With Giambra's rock-bottom approval ratings and support for the sales tax, common wisdom is that any connection to him would be political poison. Especially if you've kept your distance, as Ranzenhofer has this year. "You know, I voted against the sales tax," he says, "I voted against a pay increase, I've voted against closing ECC North Campus."

Ranzenhofer's primary opponent, Akron businessman John Schrock, says yes, his campaign made the calls with the fake Giambra voice.

Rich Kellman: "Is it a federal offense, do you think?"

Schrock: "I don't think it's a federal offense to tell the truth."

Kellman: "That's not Giambra's voice."

Schrock: "It's not Joel Giambra's voice. But there's a disclaimer at the end of the tape."

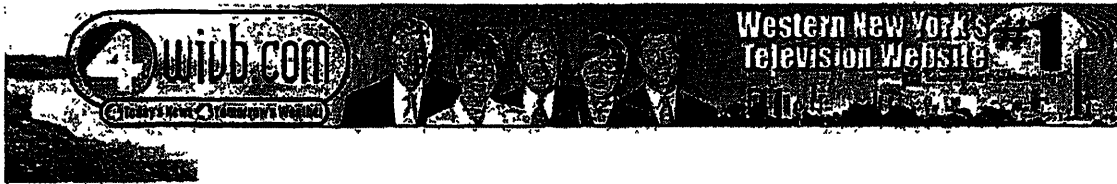
And so there is, if you listen closely. "Celebrity voice impersonation not paid for at taxpayer expense, unlike the County's pork, patronage and control board," a voice says.

Not good enough, says Ranzenhofer. But Schrock responds that Ranzenhofer put out a campaign flyer against him looking very much like former County Comptroller Alfreda Slominski.

"We live in an entertainment age, says Schrock campaign manager Curtis Ellis, "so we use an entertainment format to get out the message."

It may be entertaining, but at its heart, it's politics, in one of the most significant and possibly most unpredictable election seasons in memory.
