I AM IN RECEIPT OF A LETTER FROM "MICHAEL TONER" WHICH NOTIFIED ME THAT THE FEDERAL COMMISSION IS INVESTIGATING A POSSIBLE VIOLATION IN THE FEDERAL CAMPAIGN ACT OF 1971.

I AM PRESENTLY SERVING A 27 MONTH FEDERAL SENTENCE FOR THE SAME VIOLATION AND WAS FINED OVER \$135,000 FOR THIS VIOLATION. I DON'T UNDERSTAND HOW I CAN BE FOUND GUILTY OF THE SAME CRIME AGAIN.

I HAVE NO ACCESS TO ANY RECORDS IN REGARDS TO THIS CASE AND I HAVE NO MONEY FOR AN ATTORNEY TO REPRESENT ME.

THE STATE OF OHIO SEIZED ALL OF MY PERSONAL EFFECTS IN A SEARCH WARRANT IN MAY OF 2005. I WAS SENTENCED TO 18 YEARS IN PRISON IN NOVEMBER OF 2006 ON A SEPARATE INDICTMENT + CONVICTION IN LUCAS COUNTY, OHIO.

FURTHERMORE, THE STATE JUDGE SIGNED A RESTITUTION ORDER FOR OVER \$13 MILLION IN NOVEMBER OF 2006.

JUDGE DAVID CAIN, IN FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO, IS PRESIDING OVER A CIVIL CASE IN REGARDS TO THE STATE MATTER. IT IS SET FOR TRIAL IN FEBRUARY OF 2008.

I AM BEING TRANSFERRED FROM MILAN, MICHIGAN WITHIN THE NEXT FEW WEEKS. I DID NOT RECEIVE THE LETTER FROM MR. TONER UNTIL RECENTLY, THEREFORE THE DELAY IN MY RESPONSE SHOULD BE EXCUSED...
