The Federal Election Commission ("Commission") has considered the allegations contained in the Democratic Congressional Campaign Committee's complaint dated May 2, 2008, regarding Friends of Peter Teahen and Jeffrey Elgin, in his official capacity as treasurer, Peter Teahen, and Teahen Funeral Home, Inc.

Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint, and information supplied by the respondents, the Commission, on March 11, 2009, voted to dismiss this matter in an exercise of prosecutorial discretion. A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003).
