**Complaint of Over Limit Contributions and Request for Audit - Obama
for America (C00431445) and Obama Victory Fund (C00451393)**

Dear Sir or Madam:

This is a complaint pertaining to the Presidential Campaign Funds of Barack Obama. There are a lot of questions about his funding sources and just cursory examination of his donations for the States of ~~Maine and Maryland~~, and ~~Oklahoma~~ show marcerous contributions exceeding campaign contribution limits:

Due to the shear volume of transactions, it is not practical for an individual to review all of the donations for discrepancies however, problems are apparent just looking at filtered segments of the donations in these states. In examining 28,107 records, I found 31 donors (listing(s) attached) who contributed \$76.00 to \$2,300.00 to the Obama for America fund. In these 2 states, the amount in excess of \$4,600 per donor came to \$23,403.21. This total represents an average of \$745.94 per donor in excess of the \$4,600.00 maximum allowed.

The American People need an audit of the Obama for America (C00431445) and Obama Victory Fund (C00451393). The shear volume of transactions prohibits transparency. We are depending on the FEC to assure compliance with fair practices. Please audit the Obama Presidential Campaign Funds. Thank you for your time and consideration.

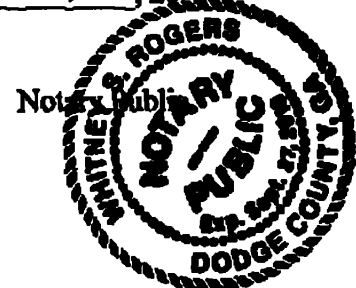
