
To Whom It May Concern:

Thank you in advance for your attention to this matter.

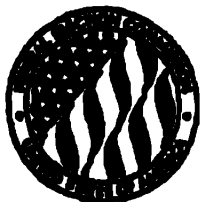
