On August 19, 2010, the Federal Election Commission notified Jim Renacci for Congress ("Committee") and Lisa Evangelista, as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On February 25, 2011, based upon the information contained in the complaint, and information provided by you on behalf of the Committee, the Commission decided to dismiss the complaint and closed its file in this matter. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter on February 25, 2011.
