Mr. Jordan,

I respectfully request that no action be taken in regard to MUR # 6624.

(Issue #1)

Mr. George Nault makes the claim that I or my state committee paid Mr. Chris Baker/Blue Point Consulting for work done on my federal campaign for Congress in 2012. This is not only speculative, but untrue. Mr. Baker was paid \$14,000 on November 11th of 2011 for state level consulting during the year of 2011. Mr. Nault claims that since I will reach my term limit for the State Senate under Arizona Statute on January 1st 2012, I would have no reason to be analyzing state level races. This also is untrue as I am still eligible to run for many other state level offices. I would also be eligible to run for the State Senate again in 2014 under Arizona Statute. On November 21st of 2011, I filed a Statement of Candidacy (Exploratory) to run for Congress. On December 30, 2011, I paid Mr. Baker the balance he was due for state level consulting of \$2,500.

Mr. Nault also makes a misrepresentation of the 2004 Arizona complaint which was a reporting error.

(Issue #2)


Mr. Nault complains that bundled contributions were improperly reported, because they lack the bundler's name "as a memo entry". This issue lacks merit, as you know that information is populated by FEC software entries. Also form 3L contains the summary of bundled contributions.

Mr. Nault complains about missing bundled contributions. The contribution from Mr. Robert Bartels was omitted by mistake and the contribution from Mr. John Popp was entered as \$0. These errors will be included in an amended report. Some of the bundled donations received were in the form of credit card information. Some of this information was incorrect, thus we were unable to process and receive these donations. Such is the case with the donations from Robert Battle, Ed Ligon and Saul Rosenzweig. We were later able to contact Mr. Ligon and Mr. Rosenzweig and obtain the correct information, process and report the donations on subsequent reports. We were unable to contact Mr. Battle to process and obtain the donation.

I believe that the information provided here should address the stated concerns and ask that no further action be taken in regard to this complaint.
