Complaint: Pursuant to 11 C.F.R. 111.4

Dear Madam Chair:

I represent the re-election committee of Congressman Jeff Landry of Louisiana. Congressman Landry and Congressman Charles Boustany of Louisiana, his opponent, are candidates in the November 6, 2012 election in the new Third Congressional District of Louisiana.

Upon information and belief, the re-election committee of Congressman Charles Boustany has engaged the professional services of "Targeted Creative Communications, Inc.," whose address appears to be P.O. Box 80126, Lafayette, LA 70598, to provide the Boustany committee with direct mail advertising services. Attached, please find the most recent example of the direct mail advertising efforts provided by Targeted Creative Communications, Inc. to the Boustany committee. This mailing was, upon information and belief, sent to all mail addresses in the new Third Congressional District. The actual number of this mailing as sent and the printing and postage cost incurred are unknown.

Although outside the Commission's formal Regulations, Congressman Landry is most upset with the absolutely false nature of this mailing. No factual material whatsoever is present in this printed material. It is a cynical attempt to confuse the voters into believing that Congressman Landry's record is different than what it is – a record of working to cut taxes and eliminate wasteful spending.

As the Commission knows, 11 C.F.R. 110.11(b) and (c)(2) requires that printed communications emanating from a federal candidate committee must include a disclaimer showing the name and address of the committee responsible for the printed communication. As you will note from the
