Dear Messrs. Brown and Coletti:

On April 10, 2014, the Federal Election Commission (the "Commission") notified Thomas Brown, Thomas Brown for Congress and George D.N. Coletti in his official capacity as treasurer, and Thomas E. Brown Jr. Sheriff (collectively "Respondents") of a complaint alleging that Respondents had violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act").

On April 27, 2017, the Commission considered the complaint but there was an insufficient number of votes to find reason to believe that Respondents violated the Act. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016. A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision will follow.
