On October 28, 2014, you were notified that the Federal Election Commission received a complaint alleging that Carolina Rising violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On October 18, 2016, the Commission considered the matter and there was an insufficient number of votes for the Commission to determine whether or not there was reason to believe that Carolina Rising violated the Act. Accordingly, on October 18, 2016, the Commission closed the file in this matter.
