This matter has been initiated on the basis of information ascertained in the normal course of the Commission's supervisory responsibilities, an investigation has been conducted, and the Commission has found reasonable cause to believe that respondent, La Gente Committee, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(1)(A)(i), (ii) by failing to timely file its 10 day Pre-Primary, 30 day Post-Primary, and 10 day Pre-General Election Reports.

Therefore, the Federal Election Commission and respondent, La Gente Committee, having duly entered into conciliation pursuant to § 437g(a)(5), do hereby agree as follows:

I. That the Federal Election Commission has jurisdiction over respondent and the subject of this proceeding.

II. That respondent has had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against him in this matter.

III. That the pertinent facts in this matter are that:

A. On December 12, 1978, the Committee filed a "3a post-card report" for the period April 1, 1978 through June 30, 1978. The Committee's 10 day Pre-Primary Report (covering the period April 1, 1978 - April 21, 1978) was due April 26, 1978, and the Committee's 30 day Post-Primary Report (covering the period April 22, 1978 - May 26, 1978) was due June 5, 1978.

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. Background

The names of six Texas committees were referred to the Office of General Counsel because they failed to file the 10 Day Pre-General Election Report in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(1)(A)(i). These reports were due on October 28, 1978. "Reason to believe" notices were sent by mailgram on October 30, 1978. "Reasonable cause to believe" notices were sent on November 1, 1978. On November 4, 1978, the names of the respondents were published.

Analysis

A discussion of the General Counsel's recommendation as to each respondent follows:

La Gente Committee (Luis A. Diaz De Leon).

Luis A. Diaz De Leon was the candidate of the La Raza Unida Party for the U. S. Senate from Texas. He received

20,370 votes less than 1% of the total vote cast. The only report filed by the La Gente Committee was the April 10 Quarterly Report. As Candidate De Leon received less than 10% of the votes cast and did not exceed \$50,000 in aggregate receipts and expenditures on previous reports the May 23 non filer procedures indicate that the Commission take no further action in connection with the La Gente Committee's failure to file the 10 Day Pre-General Report. However, the General Counsel's office recommends that further action through conciliation be taken for the following reasons. The La Gente Committee has filed no reports with the Commission, except for the April 10 Quarterly Report. The Office of General Counsel has recommended in MUR 712 that further action be taken against the Committee for its failure to file the 30 Day Post-Primary Report. The Texas Senate race was very close as is shown by the following vote totals:

Dallas 1978 Socialist Workers Campaign Committee

(James White)

James White was the candidate of the Socialist Workers Party for Texas' 5th Congressional District. He received 394 votes, 1% of the total votes cast. The Dallas 1978 Socialist Workers Campaign Committee filed its 10 Day Pre-Election report, after publication, on November 8, 1978. The report disclosed a total of \$946 in receipts and expenditures in connection with the general election. As James White received less than 10% of the votes cast and did not exceed \$25,000 in aggregate receipts and expenditures on the 10 Day Pre-Election Report, the Office of General Counsel recommends pursuant to the May 23 non-filer procedures that the Commission take no further action at this time against the Dallas 1978 Socialist Workers Campaign Committee.

Randy Evans for Congress (Randy Evans)

Randy Evans was the candidate of the Republican Party for Texas' 9th Congressional District. He received 27,067 votes, 35% of the total vote cast. The Randy Evans for Congress Committee filed its 10 Day Pre-Election Report, after publication, on November 6, 1978. The report disclosed a total of \$3,559 in receipts and expenditures in connection with the general election.

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As Candidate Evans received more than 10% of the votes cast, the Office of General Counsel recommends pursuant to the May 23 non-filer procedures that the Commission take further action through conciliation with Randy Evans for Congress Committee.

Leland for Congress (George Leland)

George (Mickey) Leland was the candidate of the Democratic Party for Texas' 18th Congressional District. He received 32,916 votes, 100% of the total vote cast. The Leland for Congress Committee filed its 10 Day Pre-Election Report, after publication on November 7, 1978. The Report filed by the Committee disclosed a total of \$53,096 in receipts and expenditures in connection with the general election and \$447,322 in receipts and expenditures in connection with the primary election. As Candidate Leland won the election, receiving 100% of the total vote cast, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission take further action through conciliation with Leland for Congress Committee.

Socialist Workers Campaign Committee (Deborah Vernier)

Deborah Vernier was the candidate of the Socialist Workers Party for the Texas' 18th Congressional District. She received less than 1% of the total vote cast. The Socialist Workers

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Campaign Committee filed its 10 Day Pre-Election Report, after publication, on November 16, 1978. The report disclosed a total of \$1,772 in receipts and expenditures in connection with the general election. As Deborah Vernier received less than 10% of the votes cast and did not exceed \$25,000 in aggregate receipts and expenditures on the 10 Day Pre-Election Report the Office of General Counsel recommends pursuant to the May 23 non filer procedures that the Commission take no further action at this time against the Socialist Workers Campaign Committee.

Agustin Mata Support Committee (Agustin Mata)

Agustin Mata was the candidate of the La Raza Unida Party for Texas' 23rd Congressional District. He received less than 1% of the total vote cast. The Agustin Mata Support Committee filed its 10 Day Pre-Election Report, after publication, on November 5, 1978. The report disclosed a total of \$4,250 in receipts and expenditures in connection with the general election and 1,360 in connection with the primary. As Agustin Mata received less than 10% of the votes cast, and did not exceed \$25,000 in aggregate receipts and expenditures on the 10 Day Pre-Election Report, the Office of General Counsel recommends pursuant to the May 23 non filer procedures that the Commission take no further action at this time against the Agustin Mata Support Committee.

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. Background

On August 25, 1978, the names of four Texas committees were referred to the Office of the General Counsel because they failed to file the 30 day Post-Primary Report in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(1)(A)(ii). These reports were due on June 5, 1978. "Reason to believe" notices were sent by mailagram on June 16, 1978. "Reasonable cause to believe" notices were sent on July 5, 1978. On August 4, 1978, the names of the respondents were published.

II. Analysis

A discussion of the General Counsel's recommendations as to each respondent follows:

Clark for Congress Committee (Stephen Ray Clark)

Stephen Ray Clark was a candidate for the nomination of the Democratic Party for the 21st Congressional District. He did not win the nomination getting only 4.2% of the total vote cast. The Clark for Congress Committee filed an April 10 Quarterly Report and a 10 day Pre-Primary Report. However, the Committee did not file the 30 day Post-Primary report which was due

June 5, 1978. Since Candidate Clark did not win the Democratic Party nomination and thus was not on the general election ballot, the Office of General Counsel recommends, pursuant to the May 23 non-filer procedures, that no further action be taken at this time against the Clark for Congress Committee.

Bobby Locke for Congress Committee (Bobby Locke)

Bobby Locke was a candidate for the nomination of the Republican Party for the 21st Congressional District. He did not win the nomination, getting only 9.7% of the total vote cast. The Bobby Locke for Congress Committee filed an April 10 Quarterly Report and a 10 day Pre-Primary Report. The Committee filed its 30 day Post-Primary Report late, one week after the publication date. In this report the Committee also checked the box to terminate. Since candidate Locke did not win the Republican Party nomination and was not on the general election ballot, the Office of General Counsel recommends, pursuant to the May 23 non-filer procedures, that no further action be taken at this time against the Clark for Congress Committee.

Liedtke for Congress Campaign Committee (Gerald Liedtke)

Gerald Brent Liedtke was a candidate for the nomination of the Democratic Party for the 22nd Congressional District. He did not win the nomination getting only 4.9% of the total vote cast. The Liedtke for Congress Campaign Committee filed an April 10 Quarterly Report, and a 10 day Pre-Primary Report. The Committee filed its 30 day Post-Primary Report late, one week after the publication date. Since Candidate Liedtke did not win

the Democratic Party nomination and was not on the general election ballot, the Office of General Counsel recommends, pursuant to the May 23 non-filer procedures, that no further action be taken at this time against the Liedtke for Congress Campaign Committee.

La Gente Committee (Luis A. Diaz De Leon)

Candidate Diaz De Leon was a candidate for the nomination of the La Raza Unida Party for the Senate. According to information furnished by the Texas Secretary of State's office, on May 6, 1978, the La Raza Unida Party held its own primary separate from the Texas state primary. In a letter dated June 22, 1978 to Dick Thomas, Maria Elena Martinez, State Chairperson of the Texas Raza Unida Party, stated that Luis A. Diaz De Leon won the La Raza Unida Party's nomination for Senate. The La Gente Committee is Louis A. Diaz De Leon's principal campaign committee. The Committee filed an April 10 Quarterly Report. On May 15, 1978, the Commission requested that the Committee furnish additional information for the Quarterly Report. There is no indication that the requested additional information was ever filed. The Committee did not file a 10 day Pre-Primary Report or a 30 day Post-Primary Report. Since candidate Louis A. Diaz De Leon won the La Raza Unida Party nomination for Senate and appeared on the general election ballot, the Office of General Counsel recommends, pursuant to the May 23 non-filer procedures, that further action be taken through conciliation against the La Gente Committee.



GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. Background

On August 25, 1978, the names of four Texas candidates or committees were referred to the Office General Counsel because they failed to file the 30-Day Post-Primary Report in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(1)(A)(ii). These reports were due on June 5, 1978. "Reason to believe" notices were sent by mailgram on June 16, 1978. "Reasonable cause to believe" notices were sent on July 5, 1978. On August 4, 1978, the names of the non-filing candidates were filed.

II. Analysis

Pursuant to the guidelines set forth by the Task Force on Nonfiling Procedures, we recommend that no further action be taken at this time against the following non-filers included in MUR 712.

Clark for Congress Committee (Stephen Ray Clark)

Stephen Ray Clark was a candidate for the nomination of the Democratic Party for the 21st Congressional District. He did not win the nomination getting only 4.2% of the total vote cast. The Clark for Congress Committee filed an April 10 Quarterly Report and a 10-Day Pre-Primary Report. However,

the Committee has not filed the 30-day Post election report which was due June 5, 1978. Since Candidate Clark did not win the Democratic Party nomination and thus will not be on the general election ballot, the Task Force guidelines would indicate that no further action should be recommended to be taken at this time.

Bobby Locke for Congress Committee

Candidate Locke was a candidate for the nomination of the Republican Party for the 21st Congressional District. He also failed to win the nomination of his Party, gaining 9.7% of the total vote cast in the Republican Party. The Bobby Locke for Congress Committee filed an April 10 Quarterly Report and a 10 day Pre-Primary Report. In addition, the committee filed a post-election report which was also a Termination Report, although the report was filed late, one week after the publication date. However, Candidate Locke did not win his Party's nomination and will not be on the general election Ballot. The Task Force guidelines would indicate that no further action should be recommended to be taken at this time.

Liedtke for Congress Campaign Committee

Candidate Gerald Brent Liedtke was a candidate for the nomination of the Democratic Party for the 22d Congressional District. He also failed to win the nomination getting only 4.9% of the vote. The Committee also filed the April 10 Quarterly Report, the 10 day Pre-Primary Report and the 30-day Post-Primary Report, although this Report was filed on

August 11, one week after the publication date. Again, however, since Candidate Liedtke did not win the primary and will not appear on the general election ballot, the Task Force guidelines would indicate that no further action be recommended at this time.

La Gente Committee

Candidate Diaz De Leon is a candidate for the nomination of the La Raza Unida Party. The La Gente Committee is the candidate's principal campaign committee. The Committee filed an April 10 Quarterly Report.

Since there is no pending investigation of the La Gente Committee's failure to file its pre-primary Report, since the candidates name did not appear on the Texas primary ballot, and since the Committee reported on its April 10 Quarterly Report receipts of only \$2,070 and expenditures of only \$2,000, the Task Force guidelines would indicate that no further action be recommended at this time.

III Recommendation

Take no further action at this time concerning the above matters and close the file.

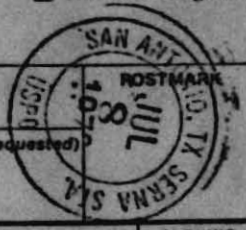
