I, Dayna C. Brown, recording secretary of the Federal Election Commission executive session, do hereby certify that on March 21, 2017, the Commission took the following actions in the above-captioned matter:

1. Failed by a vote of 2-3 to:

- a. Open a MUR.
- b. Take no action at this time with respect to Rohrabacher for Congress and Jen Slater in her official capacity as treasurer.
- c. Find reason to believe that Jack Wu knowingly and willfully violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102(b)(3) and (c), 30104(b), and 30114(b)(1) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 102.9, 102.15, and 104.3.
- d. Authorize the use of compulsory process, as necessary.
- e. Approve the Factual and Legal Analyses, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated February 2, 2017, subject to its appropriateness in the context of the entirety of the motion.
- f. Approve the appropriate letters.


a. Open a MUR.

- b. Refer Rohrabacher for Congress and Jen Slater in her official capacity as treasurer, to the Alternative Dispute Resolution Office (ADRO) for the alleged violations of 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102(c) and 30104(b) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 102.9 and 104.3, with the understanding that ADRO will refrain from processing the case until such time as the investigation conducted by the Office of General Counsel is complete.
- c. Find reason to believe that Jack Wu knowingly and willfully violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102(b)(3) and (c), 30104(b), and 30114(b)(1) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 102.9, 102.15, and 104.3.
- d. Authorize the use of compulsory process, as necessary.
- e. Approve the Factual and Legal Analyses, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated February 2, 2017.
- f. Approve the appropriate letters.
