The Office of General Counsel verified that the contributor in question, Mr. Charles Decker who was listed in your report as the Consul for Senegal, was an American Citizen. GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

ALLEGATIONS

A review of the April 10, 1978 Quarterly Report (see attachment) filed by the Cunningham for Congress Committee ("the Committee") by the Reports Analysis Division ("the Division") revealed an apparent violation of 2 U.S.C. §441e.1/ The Committee's report listed a contribution from a representative of a foreign government. This matter was referred to the Office of the General Counsel by the Reports Analysis Division on September 22, 1978.

PREVIOUS COMMISSION ACTION

According to the April 10 report, Charles Decker, listing his occupation as Consul-Diplomat representing Senegal in Los Angeles, contributed \$500 to the Committee on March 20, 1978. On June 22, the Division notified the Committee of a surface violation of 2 U.S.C. §441e and requested clarification within

1/ The Division had discovered some reporting omissions and surface violations of 2 U.S.C. 441b and the Committee has been requested to supply the Division with supplemental information. The referral file to the Office of General Counsel also contains the Division's documents dealing with these omissions.

15 days. In the absence of a response, the Commission found reason to believe that a violation of 2 U.S.C. §441e had occurred and the respondent received notification of this finding on August 14, 1978. The Division referred the matter to the Office of General Counsel when the Committee did not respond.

On September 28, a telephone conversation with a staff member of the Senegalese Embassy established that Mr. Decker was an American Citizen serving as honorary consul, (his services have since been terminated). As an honorary consul, Mr. Decker could be a citizen and resident of any nation, including the United States. (see 2 U.S.C. §611(b). Registration of Foreign Propagandists)

LEGAL ANALYSIS

2 U.S.C. §441e states that "it shall be unlawful for a foreign national...to make any...contribution, in connection with an election to any political office or...any primary election ...for any political office: or for any person to...receive any such contribution from any such foreign national."


Mr. Decker, honorary Consul-Diplomat to Senegal, was an American citizen when he made his contribution to the Committee. 2 U.S.C. §441e(b)(1) states that "the term "foreign national" shall not include any individual who is a citizen of the United States." It appears, therefore, that the Cunningham for Congress Committee did not violate 2 U.S.C. §441e.

Contributions from foreign nationals are prohibited by 2 U.S.C. 441(e) of the Act. A copy of that portion of your report is attached for your review and clarification.

The Commission recommends that if you have accepted a prohibited contribution that you return the full amount to the donor. The return of the contribution should be reported immediately by letter and should be reflected as a contribution refund on your next report of receipts and expenditures. If the contribution in question is \$6 CUNNINGHAM 4SV1/78-64 RIC please submit a statement which would clarify the public record. You may do so by amending your letter.

You have reported a transfer in from the "Cunningham Dinner Committee" for \$1,700 on 5/26/78 and \$2,000 on 6/5/78. Please amend your report to include an itemization of the contributions to the "Cunningham Dinner Committee", with the presumption that the contributions received last by the Dinner Committee are the ones transferred to the Federal campaign.

In addition, Section 114.2 and 115.2 of the FEC Regulations prohibit contributions to a Federal campaign committee by national banks, corporations, labor unions, Federal Government contractors or foreign nationals. Consequently, any funds contributed from such sources and transferred to the Federal campaign committee must be returned to the State campaign committee.

Schedule B, Line 20 itemizes an expenditure to the "First Los Angeles Bank" of \$615 for "interest on loan". A review of your reports indicates that no loan has been disclosed as having been received from the First Los Angeles Bank. FEC Regulations, Section 104.2(b)(11) requires the disclosure of the nature of all debts and obligations. This information should include the actual rate on interest charged on each loan, whether each loan has been secured, guaranteed or endorsed, and in the case of endorsers or guarantors, the identification, occupation and principal place of business must be supplied. Please amend your report to clarify the nature of your outstanding debt to the First Los Angeles Bank.
