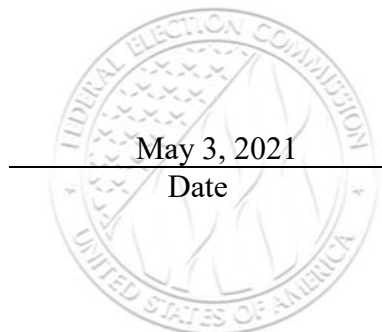
CERTIFICATION
