Now, therefore, the respective parties herein, the Federal Election Commission and respondent Committee having duly entered into conciliation pursuant to §437g(a)(5), do hereby agree as follows:

- I. That the Federal Election Commission has jurisdiction over respondent and the subject of this proceeding.
- II. That respondent Committee has had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.
- III. That the pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:
 - A. That the 10 Day Pre-Primary Report filed by the Paul Helm Committee shows Pre-Primary receipts of \$1,203 and Pre-Primary expenditures of \$525;
 - B. That the Committee, as of September 2, 1978 had failed to file its 10 Day Pre-Primary Report; the report was filed on September 12, 1978, thereby making the report 10 days late.





SUBJECT: Conciliation Agreement (MUR 748)

On November 2, 1978, the Commission voted to take action against the Paul Helm Committee (principal campaign committee for Paul Helm, senate candidate of Minnesota) for its failure to file the 10 day pre-primary election report in a timely fashion.

The respondent committee was notified of the Commission's determination and sent a conciliation agreement on November 3rd.

Attached for Commission approval is a signed conciliation agreement which provides for a civil penalty of \$100 as settlement of this matter. The Commission had originally proposed a civil penalty of \$250.

The Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission accept the attached agreement and close its file in this matter.



GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. Background

On October 5, 1978, the Office of General Counsel received from the Reports Analysis Division, the names of ten Minnesota candidates and committees which failed to file their 10 day pre-primary election reports in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434(a)(1). The reports were due on September 2, 1978. The reason to believe notices were mailed on September 4, 1978, and the reasonable cause to believe notices were mailed on September 6, 1978. On September 9, 1978, a list of those candidates and committees which failed to file the 10 day pre-primary report were published.

II. Analysis

A chart showing the name of the respondent candidates and committees, the district, the party, the number and percentage of votes, the reports filed and the financial activity listed on the reports, and whether the reason to believe and reasonable cause to believe notices were received is found in attachment I. A discussion of the General Counsel's recommendation as to each respondent follows.

A. Paul Keith Helm and the Paul Helm Committee

Respondent Paul Helm won the primary election as an unopposed senate candidate for the American Party of Minnesota.

The respondent Paul Helm Committee filed its 10 day pre-primary election report on September 12, 1978, disclosing \$1,203 in receipts and \$525 in expenditures. Mr. Helm has filed a waiver.

As Helm is a winning candidate, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission proceed to conciliation with the Paul Helm Committee pursuant to the Commission guidelines of May 23, 1978.

B. Malcolm Moos and Minnesotans for Moos

Respondent Malcolm Moos lost the primary election as a senate candidate for the Republican Party receiving 32,002 votes (15.6 percent of the total votes cast). Mr. Moos has neither filed a waiver nor a 10 day pre-primary election report.

The Minnesotans for Moos Committee filed its 10 day pre-primary election report before publication on September 5, 1978, disclosing \$4,605 in receipts and \$6,356 in expenditures.

As set forth in the Commission guidelines of May 23, 1978, no further action will be taken against any candidate whose committee filed before publication. Further, Mr. Moos lost the election receiving under 30 percent of the vote. Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends that no further action be taken at this time against Malcolm Moos.

C. Emil Moses

Respondent Emil Moses lost the primary election as a senate candidate for the Democratic Farm Labor Party receiving 10,053 votes (2.0 percent of the total votes cast). Mr. Moses filed a 10 day pre-primary election report in the form of a letter before publication on September 7, 1978, disclosing no financial activity.

As set forth in the Commission guidelines of May 23, 1978, no further action will be taken against any candidate who files prior to publication. Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends that no further action be taken at this time against Emil Moses.

D. Richard A. Palmer

Respondent Richard A. Palmer, lost the primary election as a senate candidate for the Democratic Farm Labor Party receiving 8,729 votes (1.6 percent of the total votes cast). Respondent is an unregistered candidate and has filed no reports of receipts and expenditures in connection with the 1978 election.

As set forth in the October 26, 1978, amendment to Commission guidelines no further action will be taken against any candidate who files no reports with the Commission and for whom no financial activity is available and who loses the election receiving less than 30 percent of the votes. Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends that no further action be taken at this time against Mr. Palmer.

E. Lloyd M. Roberts

Respondent Lloyd M. Roberts lost the primary election as a senate candidate for the Democratic Party receiving 12,643 votes (2.6 percent of the total votes cast). Respondent is an unregistered candidate and has filed no reports of receipts and expenditures in connection with the 1978 election.

In addition to being referred to the Office of General Counsel as a 10 day pre-primary non-filer, Roberts was referred on October 17th for failure to file a statement of candidacy

and designate a principal campaign committee. 1/

As set forth in the October 26, 1978, amendment to Commission guidelines no further action will be taken against any candidate who files no reports with the Commission and for whom no financial activity is available and who loses the election receiving less than 30 percent of the votes. Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends that no further action be taken at this time against Mr. Roberts.

F. David A. Drummond and the David Drummond for U.S. Congress Committee

Respondent David Drummond lost the primary election as a candidate for the House of Representatives, 1st district, for the Republican Party receiving 4,105 votes (11.5 percent of the total cast).

Neither the Respondent candidate nor his committee have filed any reports in connection with the 1978 election.

As set forth in the October 26, 1978, amendment to Commission guidelines no further action will be taken against any committee or candidate who files no reports with the Commission and for whom no financial activity is available and who loses the election receiving less than 30 percent of the votes. Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends that no further action

be taken at this time against David A. Drummond or the David Drummond for U.S. Congress Committee.

G. Robert C. Olson

Respondent Robert C. Olson lost the primary election as a candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives, 1st district, for the Democratic Farm Labor Party receiving 11,277 votes (23.5 percent of the total votes cast). The candidate has not filed reports of receipts and expenditures; however, he did send in a letter on September 12th indicating that no funds have been received or expended in connection with his election.

The Olson for Congress Committee filed a statement of organization on September 22, 1978, subsequent to the primary election; the committee has filed no reports of receipts and expenditures.

As set forth in Commission guidelines of May 23, 1978, no further action will be taken against any candidate who loses the election receiving less than 30 percent of the votes and who has financial activity less than \$25,000. Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends that no further action be taken at this time against Robert C. Olson.

H. Bill O. Kjeldahl

Respondent Bill O. Kjeldahl lost the primary election as a candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives, 7th district, for the Democratic Farm Labor Party receiving 15,324 votes (26.9 percent of the total votes cast). The candidate filed a 10 day pre-primary election report on September 25, 1978, indicating no receipts or expenditures.

As set forth in Commission guidelines of May 23, 1978, no further action will be taken against any candidate who loses the election receiving less than 30 percent of the votes and who has financial activity less than \$25,000. Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends taking no further action at this time against Bill O. Kjeldahl.

III. Recommendation

1. Take further action against the Paul Helm Committee through conciliation. Send the attached conciliation agreement and letter.



CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter has been initiated on the basis of information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities, an investigation has been conducted, and the Commission has found reasonable cause to believe that respondent, Paul Helm Committee (the Committee), violated 2 U.S.C. §434(a)(1)(A)(i) by filing its 10 Day Pre-Primary Election Report late;

Now, therefore, the respective parties herein, the Federal Election Commission and respondent Committee having duly entered into conciliation pursuant to §437g(a)(5), do hereby agree as follows:

- I. That the Federal Election Commission has jurisdiction over respondent and the subject of this proceeding.
- II. That respondent Committee has had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.
- III. That the pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:
 - A. That the 10 Day Pre-Primary Report filed by the Paul Helm Committee shows Pre-Primary receipts of \$1,203 and Pre-Primary expenditures of \$525;
 - B. That the Committee, as of September 2, 1978 had failed to file its 10 Day Pre-Primary Report; the report was filed on September 12, 1978, thereby making the report 10 days late.

THEREFORE, respondent Committee agrees:

- I. Respondent's action in failing to file its 10 Day Pre-Primary Election Report on September 2, 1978, was in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434(a)(1)(A)(i).
- II. That it will pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$250 pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §437g(a)(6)(B)(i).
- III. Respondent agrees that it will not undertake any activity which is in violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, 2 U.S.C. §431, et seq.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- I. The Commission, on the request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. §437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein, or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.
- II. It is mutually agreed that this agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.
- III. It is agreed that respondent Committee shall have no more than thirty (30) days from the date of this

agreement to implement and comply with the
requirement contained herein, or so notify
the Commission.

On September 6, 1978, the Commission found reasonable cause to believe that the Paul Helm Committee, violated 2 U.S.C. §434 for filing its 10 Day Pre-Primary Election Report late.

The Commission has a duty to attempt to correct such violations for a period of 30 days by informal methods of conference, conciliation and persuasion, and by entering into a conciliation agreement. 2 U.S.C. §437g(a)(5)(A). If we are unable to reach an agreement during that period, the Commission may institute civil suit in the United States District Court and seek payment of a civil penalty not in excess of \$5000.

We enclose a proposed conciliation agreement that the Commission offers as settlement of this matter.

If you agree with the provisions of the enclosed conciliation agreement, please sign and return it along with the civil penalty, to the Commission within ten days. I will then recommend that the Commission approve the agreement.

If we are unable to agree upon a conciliation agreement, the Office of General Counsel is prepared to recommend to the Commission that civil suit be filed against you.





GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. Background

On October 5, 1978, the Office of General Counsel received from the Reports Analysis Division, the names of ten Minnesota candidates and committees which failed to file their 10 day pre-primary election reports in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434(a)(1). The reports were due on September 2, 1978. The reason to believe notices were mailed on September 4, 1978, and the reasonable cause to believe notices were mailed on September 6, 1978. On September 9, 1978, a list of those candidates and committees which failed to file the 10 day pre-primary report were published.

II. Analysis

A chart showing the name of the respondent candidates and committees, the district, the party, the number and percentage of votes, the reports filed and the financial activity listed on the reports, and whether the reason to believe and reasonable cause to believe notices were received is found in attachment I. A discussion of the General Counsel's recommendation as to each respondent follows.

A. Paul Keith Helm and the Paul Helm Committee

Respondent Paul Helm won the primary election as an unopposed senate candidate for the American Party of Minnesota.

The respondent Paul Helm Committee filed its 10 day pre-primary election report on September 12, 1978, disclosing \$1,203 in receipts and \$525 in expenditures. Mr. Helm has filed a waiver.

As Helm is a winning candidate, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission proceed to conciliation with the Paul Helm Committee pursuant to the Commission guidelines of May 23, 1978.

B. Malcolm Moos and Minnesotans for Moos

Respondent Malcolm Moos lost the primary election as a senate candidate for the Republican Party receiving 32,002 votes (15.6 percent of the total votes cast). Mr. Moos has neither filed a waiver nor a 10 day pre-primary election report.

The Minnesotans for Moos Committee filed its 10 day pre-primary election report before publication on September 5, 1978, disclosing \$4,605 in receipts and \$6,356 in expenditures.

As set forth in the Commission guidelines of May 23, 1978, no further action will be taken against any candidate whose committee filed before publication. Further, Mr. Moos lost the election receiving under 30 percent of the vote. Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends that no further action be taken at this time against Malcolm Moos.

C. Emil Moses

Respondent Emil Moses lost the primary election as a senate candidate for the Democratic Farm Labor Party receiving 10,053 votes (2.0 percent of the total votes cast). Mr. Moses filed a 10 day pre-primary election report in the form of a letter before publication on September 7, 1978, disclosing no financial activity.

As set forth in the Commission guidelines of May 23, 1978, no further action will be taken against any candidate who files prior to publication. Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends that no further action be taken at this time against Emil Moses.

D. Richard A. Palmer

Respondent Richard A. Palmer, lost the primary election as a senate candidate for the Democratic Farm Labor Party receiving 8,729 votes (1.6 percent of the total votes cast). Respondent is an unregistered candidate and has filed no reports of receipts and expenditures in connection with the 1978 election.

As set forth in the October 26, 1978, amendment to Commission guidelines no further action will be taken against any candidate who files no reports with the Commission and for whom no financial activity is available and who loses the election receiving less than 30 percent of the votes. Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends that no further action be taken at this time against Mr. Palmer.

E. Lloyd M. Roberts

Respondent Lloyd M. Roberts lost the primary election as a senate candidate for the Democratic Party receiving 12,643 votes (2.6 percent of the total votes cast). Respondent is an unregistered candidate and has filed no reports of receipts and expenditures in connection with the 1978 election.

In addition to being referred to the Office of General Counsel as a 10 day pre-primary non-filer, Roberts was referred on October 17th for failure to file a statement of candidacy

and designate a principal campaign committee. 1/

As set forth in the October 26, 1978, amendment to Commission guidelines no further action will be taken against any candidate who files no reports with the Commission and for whom no financial activity is available and who loses the election receiving less than 30 percent of the votes. Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends that no further action be taken at this time against Mr. Roberts.

F. David A. Drummond and the David Drummond for U.S. Congress Committee

Respondent David Drummond lost the primary election as a candidate for the House of Representatives, 1st district, for the Republican Party receiving 4,105 votes (11.5 percent of the total cast).

Neither the Respondent candidate nor his committee have filed any reports in connection with the 1978 election.

As set forth in the October 26, 1978, amendment to Commission guidelines no further action will be taken against any committee or candidate who files no reports with the Commission and for whom no financial activity is available and who loses the election receiving less than 30 percent of the votes. Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends that no further action

G. Robert C. Olson

Respondent Robert C. Olson lost the primary election as a candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives, 1st district, for the Democratic Farm Labor Party receiving 11,277 votes (23.5 percent of the total votes cast). The candidate has not filed reports of receipts and expenditures; however, he did send in a letter on September 12th indicating that no funds have been received or expended in connection with his election.

The Olson for Congress Committee filed a statement of organization on September 22, 1978, subsequent to the primary election; the committee has filed no reports of receipts and expenditures.

As set forth in Commission guidelines of May 23, 1978, no further action will be taken against any candidate who loses the election receiving less than 30 percent of the votes and who has financial activity less than \$25,000. Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends that no further action be taken at this time against Robert C. Olson.

H. Bill O. Kjeldahl

Respondent Bill O. Kjeldahl lost the primary election as a candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives, 7th district, for the Democratic Farm Labor Party receiving 15,324 votes (26.9 percent of the total votes cast). The candidate filed a 10 day pre-primary election report on September 25, 1978, indicating no receipts or expenditures.

As set forth in Commission guidelines of May 23, 1978, no further action will be taken against any candidate who loses the election receiving less than 30 percent of the votes and who has financial activity less than \$25,000. Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends taking no further action at this time against Bill O. Kjeldahl.



On September 6, 1978, the Commission found reasonable cause to believe that the Paul Helm Committee, violated 2 U.S.C. §434 for filing its 10 Day Pre-Primary Election Report late.

The Commission has a duty to attempt to correct such violations for a period of 30 days by informal methods of conference, conciliation and persuasion, and by entering into a conciliation agreement. 2 U.S.C. §437g(a)(5)(A). If we are unable to reach an agreement during that period, the Commission may institute civil suit in the United States District Court and seek payment of a civil penalty not in excess of \$5000.

We enclose a proposed conciliation agreement that the Commission offers as settlement of this matter.

If you agree with the provisions of the enclosed conciliation agreement, please sign and return it along with the civil penalty, to the Commission within ten days. I will then recommend that the Commission approve the agreement.

If we are unable to agree upon a conciliation agreement, the Office of General Counsel is prepared to recommend to the Commission that civil suit be filed against you.
