The Federal Election Commission (the "Commission") has considered the allegations contained in your complaint dated October 16, 2018 but was equally divided on whether to find reason to believe or dismiss the allegations that the respondents violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Accordingly, on September 28, 2021, the Commission closed the file in this matter. A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).

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The Federal Election Campaign Act allows a complainant to seek judicial review of the Commission's dismissal of this action. *See* 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(8).
