Dear Ms. Lam:

On February 5, 2020, the Federal Election Commission notified you of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"). A copy of the complaint was forwarded to you at that time.

On July 5, 2024, the Commission notified you that on June 27, 2024, it voted to dismiss the allegation that you violated 52 U.S.C. § 30122, a provision of the Act, in connection with the contribution from the Society of Young Women Scientists and Engineers LLC to 1820 PAC. The Commission, on January 14, 2025, voted to close this matter effective February 13, 2025.
