GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. BACKGROUND

In 1978 the Reports Analysis Division referred to the Office of General Counsel all candidates and committees which failed to timely file one or more of the following reports: the 1977 year-end report, the 10 day pre-primary report, the 30 day post-primary report, and the 10 day pre-general report.

The Commission reviewed all of the candidates and committees which failed to file and in accordance with the criteria set forth in the Commission's non-filer memorandum dated May 23, 1978, determined to take further action through conciliation against a number of the candidates and committees. For those candidates and committees which did not conciliate, the Commission found probable cause. 1/ The Commission directed the Office of General Counsel to review all of the candidates and committees against which probable cause was found and to recommend to the Commission those candidates and committees against which a civil action should be filed.2/

-
- 1/ Except for those candidates and committees which failed to file the 1977 year-end report, the Commission did not authorize the filing of civil suits.
- 2/ Four candidates and one committee against which the Commission found probable cause for failure to file reports of receipts and expenditures are not included in this report. They are: the Committee Amigos de Jaime Benitez, NF 54 (Puerto Rico); the New York State Voter Registration Drive, NF 59 (New York); the Committee to Elect Louis Nine to Congress, NF 62 (New York); the North Carolina Democratic Inaugural Committee, NF 70 (North Carolina); and Sanford Krasnoff, NF 193 (Louisiana). Civil actions for failure to timely file and for other violations of FECA were brought against the Committee Amigos de Jaime Benitez and Sanford Krasnoff. A civil action for failure to timely file was brought against the Committee to Elect Louis Nine to Congress and a consent decree has been obtained. The New York State Voter Registration Drive was referred to the Audit Division for an audit. Conciliation is proceeding for failure to timely file and for other violations of FECA with the North Carolina Democratic Inaugural Committee in MUR 859.

II. ANALYSIS

A. 1977 Year-End Non-Filers

The Commission has found probable cause against the following 1977 year-end non-filers:

Allen Blume for Congress	(Alaska)

Attachment I lists each respondent and indicates each respondent's filing history and financial activity for 1978.

All of the respondents are principal campaign committees of candidates who ran for election to federal office in 1976. None of the candidates ran for election to federal office in 1978. The respondent committees appear to be defunct. As none of the respondents filed 1978 quarterly reports there is no indication of financial activity.

Because of the inactivity of these committees in the 1978 elections, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission not bring a civil action for relief against them, but close the files.

Attachment II lists each respondent and indicates each respondent's filing history and financial activity for 1978.

The General Counsel's Office used three criteria in reviewing the respondents. We are recommending the filing

of a civil action against any respondent who meets all three criteria. The criteria are as follows:

1. whether the respondent failed to timely file two of the 1978 reports;
2. whether the respondent (or the candidate if the respondent was a principal campaign committee) received more than 30% of the vote in either the primary or general election; and
3. whether the respondent had more than \$20,000 in receipts.

One committee, Conlin for Congress, meets all three criteria: failing to timely file both the 10 day pre-general election report and the 30 day post-general election report, receiving 42% of the vote in the general election, and having receipts in the amount of \$160,614.

The Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission bring a civil action for relief against Conlin for Congress. Further, we recommend closing the files with respect to all other respondents.

III. RECOMMENDATIONS

The Office of General Counsel recommends the following:

1. file a civil action against Conlin for Congress (NF 173) for failure to file required reports in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434;
2. close the file and rescind the authorization to file a civil action with regard to:

I. BACKGROUND:

The Reports Analysis Division referred to the Office of the General Counsel the names of six candidates and committees which failed to file their 10 Day Pre-General Election Report. On January 25, 1979, the Commission voted to take no further action with respect to William A. Clark, Dunstan Lionel Haettenschwiller, and Committee to Elect Jim Peck. The Commission voted to continue compliance with regards to Larry Penner, Leo J. Kesselring, and People for Poth. Letters and conciliation agreements were sent to the respondents on January 25, 1979. The Commission approved an agreement signed by Mr. Kesselring as settlement in this matter on March 27, 1979.

II. ANALYSIS:

LARRY PENNER

Correspondence sent to Mr. Penner has been returned to the Commission marked, "UNCLAIMED." Mr. Penner does not have a listed phone number; therefore, we were unable to reach him by phone. No response has been received from Mr. Penner and the 30 day time period for conciliation has expired.

On September 20, 1978 and November 1, 1978, the Commission found reasonable cause to believe that you violated 2 U.S.C. §432(e)(1) and 11 C.F.R. §101.2 for failing to file a candidate statement and designate a principal campaign committee; and 2 U.S.C. §434(a)(1) for failing to file a Ten Day Pre-Election Report.

The Commission has a duty to attempt to correct such violations for a period of 30 days by informal methods of conference, conciliation, and persuasion, and by entering into a conciliation agreement. 2 U.S.C. §437g(a)(5)(A). If we are unable to reach an agreement during that period, the Commission may institute civil suit in the United States District Court and seek payment of a civil penalty.

We enclose a proposed conciliation agreement that this office is prepared to recommend to the Commission in settlement of this matter.



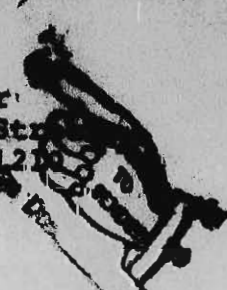

General Counsel's Report

I. Background:

The Reports Analysis Division referred to the Office of the General Counsel the names of candidates and committees which failed to file a 10 Day Pre-Election report for the general election in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434(a)(1). The reports were due October 28, 1978. The reason to believe notices were sent on October 30, 1978 and the reasonable cause to believe notices were mailed November 1, 1978. On November 4, 1978, a list of those candidates and committees which failed to file the 10 Day Pre-Election report for the general election were published.

II. Analysis:

A copy of the Reports Analysis Referral (Exhibit I) and a New York non-filer chart (Exhibit II) are attached.

WILLIAM A. CLARK

Respondent William Clark was a Libertarian candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives. He lost the general election receiving 1,686 votes or 1% of the votes cast. The respondent filed his Ten Day Pre-Election report after publication listing \$0 receipts and expenditures. As

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respondent William Clark received less than 10% of the votes cast and had minimal financial activity, the Office of the General Counsel, in accordance with the Commission's non-filer procedures dated May 23, 1978, recommends taking no further action against respondent William Clark.

LARRY PENNER

Respondent Larry Penner was a Republican candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives. Mr. Penner lost the general election receiving 9,405 votes or 13% of the votes cast. His name was also referred to the Office of the General Counsel for failing to file a candidate statement and designate a principal campaign committee (See Exhibit III). Respondent Larry Penner has not filed a 10 Day Pre-Election report. He previously filed a miscellaneous document on September 22, 1978, which listed \$0 financial activity and stated that he did not designate a principal campaign committee due to a lack of expenditures. As respondent Larry Penner received more than 10% of the votes cast, the Office of the General Counsel, in accordance with the Commission's non-filer procedures dated May 23, 1978, recommends that the Commission initiate conciliation with respondent Larry Penner.

LEO J. KESSELRING

Respondent Leo J. Kesselring was a Conservative candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives. He lost

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the election receiving 18,127 votes or 13% of the votes cast. A committee named, Kesselring for Congress, which has neither registered with the Commission nor was designated by the candidate on a candidate statement, filed a 10 Day Pre-Election report after publication. The report listed \$1225 in receipts and \$911 in expenditures. The report also states that the report "represents all receipts and expenditures from September 1, 1978 which was the date of designation of the candidate and the committee known as 'Kesselring for Congress'...". Mr. Kesselring's name was also referred to the Office of the General Counsel for failing to file a candidate statement and designate a principal campaign committee in violation of 2 U.S.C. §432 (e)(1) and 11 C.F.R. §101.2. As the respondent received more than 10% of the votes cast, the Office of the General Counsel recommends in accordance with the Commission non-filer procedures dated May 23, 1978, that the Commission initiate conciliation with respondent Leo Kesselring.

DUNSTAN LIONEL HAETTENSCHWILLER

Respondent Dunstan Haettenschwiller was a Conservative candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives. He lost the election receiving 1,501 votes or 2% of the votes cast. The candidate designated a principal campaign committee and waived his reporting requirements on his candidate statement filed September 20, 1978. The principal campaign committee

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did not register until October 30, 1978; and, therefore, only the candidate was tracked for failing to file a 10 Day Pre-Election report. Respondent Dunstan Haettenschwiller filed a 10 Day Pre-Election report after publication. The report listed \$0 receipts and expenditures. As respondent Dunstan Haettenschwiller received less than 10% of the vote cast and reported minimal financial activity, the Office of the General Counsel recommends, in accordance with the Commission's non-filer procedures dated May 23, 1978, that no further action should be taken against respondent Dunstan Haettenschwiller.

COMMITTEE TO ELECT JIM PECK

Mr. Peck was a Liberal candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives. He lost the election receiving 6,204 votes or 5% of the votes cast. Respondent Committee to Elect Jim Peck filed its 10 Day Pre-Election report after publication. The report listed \$3308 in receipts and \$3308 in expenditures. As the candidate received less than 10% of the votes cast and the committee reported minimal financial activity, the Office of the General Counsel, in accordance with the Commission's non-filer procedures dated May 23, 1978, recommends that no further action be taken against respondent Committee to Elect Jim Peck.

PEOPLE FOR POTH

Charles Poth III was a Republican candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives. He lost the general election

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receiving 17,585 votes or 19% of the votes cast. The respondent, People for Poth, filed a Ten Day Pre-Election report on January 11, 1979 listing \$0 receipts, \$0 expenditures, and an outstanding debt of \$7,595.36. Previous reports filed in 1978 revealed financial activity aggregating \$4,253.24. As the candidate received more than 10% of the votes cast, the Office of the General Counsel, in accordance with the Commission's non-filer procedures dated May 23, 1978, recommends initiating conciliation with respondent People For Poth.


III. Recommendation:

1) Take no further action and close the file with respect to respondents William A. Clark, Dunstan Lionel Haettenschwiller, and Committee to Elect Jim Peck.

2) Initiate conciliation with respondents Larry Penner, Leo J. Kesselring, and People for Poth. Approve the attached conciliation agreements. Send the attached letters.




