Dear Mr. Ramba:

On August 24, 2020, the Federal Election Commission notified Conservatives for Effective Government and you, as treasurer ("CFEG"), of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On April 26, 2022, the Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided on whether to find reason to believe that CFEG violated 52 U.S.C. § 30125(e). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). One or more Statements of Reasons, which more fully explain the Commission's decision, will follow.
