This pertains to the candidate's internet communications, specifically campaign internet advertisements for social media channels such as YouTube (see attached), Facebook and Twitter.

Voters have openly questioned me as I canvas the state for primary election votes....."Why are you making a big deal about this"?

Because, I, for one, want to know who's behind funding the Harbick campaign.

If sitting congressman Darrell Issa, who has endorsed Harbick's campaign, or any other Non-Candidate Committee is funding the ads, voters deserve to know.
