This firm represents Save America and Bradley Crate in his official capacity as treasurer (the "Committee"), and we are in receipt of the complaint in the above-referenced matter. Despite the Commission's cover letter stating the contrary, the complaint includes no information, and makes no allegation, that the Committee violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. All contributions received by the Committee are thoroughly reviewed in accordance with FEC rules and regulations, and if there was any indication that the contributions in question were fraudulent, they would have been rejected and reported to the appropriate authorities.

Complainant may want to consider the possibility that in a state of almost 40 million people, there may well be more than one Stephen Nelson. Perhaps Stephen Nelson, television play-by-play commentator for the Los Angeles Dodgers. Or maybe Stephen Nelson, Senior Vice President of Global Operations at XCast Labs, the employer reported by the Committee for the contributions in question.
