Dear Ms. Bukovinac:

On June 11, 2024, the Federal Election Commission notified you of a complaint alleging that Progressive Anti-Abortion Uprising may have violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"). A copy of the Complaint was forwarded to you at that time. On January 8, 2025, on the basis of the information in the complaint and information provided by PAAU, the Commission determined to exercise its prosecutorial discretion to dismiss the allegations contained in the Complaint. Accordingly, on January 8, 2025, the Commission voted to close the file in this matter effective February 12, 2025.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record today. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
