Upon receipt of your letter dated July 22, 1981, I phoned your attorney, Gary L. Johansen. We discussed the matter.


Arizonans For Life are not now and never have been affiliated with another political committee.



Dear Ms. Lichfield:

Information has come available to the Federal Election Commission, in the normal course of its supervisory responsibilities, which indicates that you may be affiliated with other right to life committees registered with the Commission. This matter is designated MUR 996.

For purposes of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, all committees which are established, financed, maintained or controlled by the same person or group of persons are considered to be affiliated. See 11 C.F.R. § 100.5(g). Affiliated committees are required to state such affiliation on their statements of organization pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 433(b)(2) (see 11 C.F.R. § 102.2), and share a single contribution limitation pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(5) (see 11 C.F.R. § 110.3).

After consideration of this matter, the Commission on July 14, 1981, determined to take no action at this time regarding whether the various right to life committees registered with the Commission are affiliated. This matter will become part of the public record within 30 days.


If, after a review of your activities, you determine that you are affiliated with another political committee, please amend your statement of organization to show such affiliation and take notice that all contributions made by affiliated committees for purposes of contribution limitations are considered to have been made by a single political committee.




