You have served upon Mr. Carl Davis a complaint alleging a violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("The Act"). In accordance with the rules stated in your communication dated November 1, 2012, the following is Mr. Davis's response submitted to the Commission within the proscribed fifteen day response time.


The complainant, Irmalyn Thomas, alleges Mr. Davis contributed \$5,000.00 to the "Weber for Congress" campaign when he was only allowed to contribute \$2,500.00. It appears that the campaign contribution was incorrectly credited to only Mr. Davis. The campaign contribution was not just from Mr. Davis but also from his wife, Mrs. Davis. Both Mr. and Mrs. Davis signed the contribution check signifying that the contribution was from both, making the contribution \$2,500.00 each.

Since the contribution was from both Mr. and Mrs. Davis the contribution did not exceed allowable contributions under "The Act".

Mr. and Mrs. Davis would of course prefer this matter to remain confidential. However it must be noted that Ms. Irmalyn Thomas, Complainant, filed the complaint with the Lone Star Project and it was published on its web site at www.lonestarproject.net/files/WeberFEC.pdf.
