1. Find reason to believe that American Hotel & Lodging Association and American Hotel & Lodging Association Political Action Committee and Joorie Jeon in her official capacity as treasurer violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b(b)(3)(B), (C) and 11 C.F.R. § 114.5(a)(3), (4) with respect to the 2011 fundraiser.
2. Dismiss the allegation that American Hotel & Lodging Association and American Hotel & Lodging Association Political Action Committee and Joorie Jeon in her official capacity as treasurer violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b(b)(4)(A)(i) and 11 C.F.R. § 114.5(g)(1) with respect to the solicitation for the 2012 HotelPAC fundraiser.
3. Dismiss the allegation that The Broadmoor Hotel, Inc. violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b(b)(3)(B), (C) and (4)(A)(i), and 11 C.F.R. § 114.5(a)(3),(4) and (g)(1), but send a letter of caution.
4. Approve the Factual and Legal Analyses, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated February 19, 2013, with edits as previously circulated by Commissioner Petersen's Office.

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5. Approve the appropriate letters.
6. Instruct the General Counsel's Office to draft an appropriate conciliation agreement that reflects the areas of agreement, and circulate it on a 48 hour tally vote.

Commissioners Hunter, McGahn II, Petersen, Walther, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the decision.
