Dear Mr. Dye:

This is in response to your letter of September 25 and our phone conversation of September 26 in which you requested an extension until Friday, October 3 to produce certain cost information relating to 1992 activities of your client, National Right to Work Committee (NRTWC). This cost information was initially requested in the Commission's February 1997 subpoena and order to NRTWC and, in an effort to aid in NRTWC's search efforts, was more specifically delineated in my September 4, 1997 letter sent to you after review of other documents produced by NRTWC. In your September 25 letter and in our phone call, you stated that NRTWC could not complete its search of relevant stored records by September 26 but is "comfortable" that it can do so by October 3, 1997. You also stated that your client is currently involved in other legal matters that have also required its attention. Accordingly, the Office of the General Counsel will grant NRTWC an additional extension until close of business on October 3, 1997. Please be aware however, that in light of the fact that cost information has been sought since February 1997, this Office will be unable to grant further extensions.
