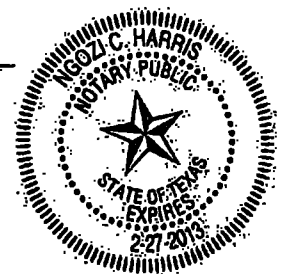


Affidavit of Shawn C. Phillips

On this day, Shawn C. Phillips appeared before me, the undersigned notary public, and after I administered an oath to the said affiant, the affiant did swear and state as follows:


1. My name is Shawn C. Phillips. I am over 18 years of age and am competent to make this affidavit. I have knowledge of the following facts, which are true and correct.
2. Attached hereto as Exhibit A are true and correct copies of mass marketing emails that were sent by an email service paid for by Heidi for Texas, Inc., a Texas specific purpose political committee with the sole designated purpose of electing Heidi Thiess to the Texas Legislature. Heidi for Texas, Inc. is not registered with the Federal Election Commission.
3. Attached as Exhibit B are true and correct copies of mass marketing emails that were sent by an email service paid for by the Heidi Thiess campaign. The Heidi Thiess campaign was a campaign to elect Ms. Thiess to the Texas Legislature in 2012. The Heidi Thiess campaign is not registered with the Federal Election Commission.
4. The emails contained in Exhibit B contain references to and electronically piggybacked upon a website, www.heidifortexas.com, which according to campaign finance reports filed with the Texas Ethics Commission, was paid for by the specific purpose committee Heidi for Texas, Inc. Heidi for Texas, Inc. is not registered with the Federal Election Commission. Campaign finance reports indicate further that the campaigns purchased electronic advertising to drive additional traffic to the site.
5. Exhibit A and Exhibit B are political communications advocating on behalf of federal election candidates, including candidate for Texas Senate Ted Cruz, candidate for U.S. Congress Robert Gonzalez, candidate for U.S. Congress Felicia Harris, candidate for U.S. Congress Wes Riddle, and candidate for U.S. Congress Steve Stockman.
6. The Federal Election Commission defines regulated electronic communications to include emails of more than 500 substantially similar communications. Upon information and belief, the emails contained in Exhibit A and Exhibit B were distributed to more than 500 email addresses in substantially similar form and therefore were regulated communications.
7. As detailed in the Special Notices on Political Ads and Solicitations, published by the FEC in October 2006 and available via the FEC's website, "bulk electronic email (defined as electronic mail with more than 500


substantially similar communications)" must contain a disclosure. Such disclosure, in the event the communication was not approved by the candidate being advertised, must state that they are "not authorized by any candidate or candidate's committee." The electronic communications attached as Exhibit A and Exhibit B contained no such disclaimers.

8. Further, upon information and belief, the total cost to maintain accounts with the mass email distribution services, maintain the website they were linked to, and purchase other electronic advertising (including Facebook ads) driving traffic to those sites exceeded \$250. Such expenditures were used to promote the election of candidates to federal office. Accordingly, Heidi Thiess and Heidi for Texas Campaign, Inc. should have filed FEC Form 5 with the Commission, reporting the contributions and expenditures from these campaigns, but no such reports were filed, apparently in violation of federal election law.

So ignore them and find people you trust with skin in the game.

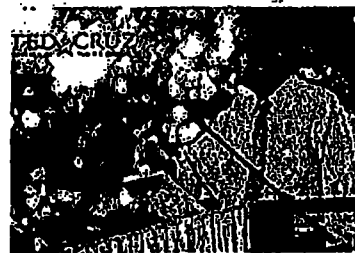
