This email follows-up on our conversation this morning.

As we discussed, I wish to make it perfectly clear that SteppingStone Industries does NOT wish to contribute the \$7,755.00 to the Stein campaign. I have submitted a total of five invoices to the Stein campaign (two prior to providing the services and three after the candidate was confirmed on the ballot in Virginia) and I would prefer that the campaign pay for the services that we provided in good faith. All invoices were clearly identified on SteppingStone Industries, Inc letterhead.

Additional new information: the Stein campaign has paid one of the other petitioners for their petitions at a lower rate. The petitioner that did receive payment worked locally and did not incur expenses of travel and I did. Collecting signatures by travel in less populated areas makes it more time consuming and costly. It would have been unethical of me (us) had I also collected signatures locally and charged less since the signatures would not have contributed to successful ballot access for the candidate under Virginia statute.
