I am the wife of Jim Anderson and an owner/manager of a PostNet franchise in Wichita, KS, located at 11310 E 21st N, Suite G. The accusation that multiple persons are doing business out of our location is false. The only business operating at this address is PostNet. As evidence by the complaint exhibit# 5, that Deterding submitted, the address a business listed is followed by a PMB#, which is legally a different address from our business location. We have approximately 100 private mailboxes that we rent and all are considered legally to be separate addresses. We charge the same rate for all mailboxes (per size rented).

These accusations were reported on the front page of the business section/paper of the Wichita Eagle, on July 9, 2014 and July 10, 2014. In those articles Deterding at first claims she acted independently, then admits that she had contact with and received details in the complaint from the Pompeo campaign. I contacted the associated press reporter and asked her how she came by the accusations and she said Deterding provided her with a copy of complaint. I would like for our naming in this complaint to please remain confidential.


