Dear Ms. Pike:

This letter replaces my letter mailed to you on March 1, 2016.

On January 8, 2015, the Federal Election Commission notified you of a complaint alleging that Paul Spain for Congress and you in your official capacity as treasurer had violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On February 23, 2016, the Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided on whether there was no reason to believe the Act was violated. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70426 (Dec. 18, 2003) and Statement of Policy Regarding Placing First General Counsel's Reports on the Public Record, 74 Fed. Reg. 66132 (Dec. 14, 2009). A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision is not required in this matter, but if one is issued, it will be provided to you.
