Dear Mz Hampton,

This morning I left a voice-mail for you as I have a few questions about this lawsuit. But my general response is below.

I, Robert Joswiak, realize that under MUR 6916, my campaign is a part of a lawsuit against Catalist and NGP-VAN. I also realize this is based upon the idea that campaigns, including mine, somehow benefited from 'in-kind' help from these organizations that went unreported to the FEC. In short, I know that I, nor anyone on my campaign, did anything wrong. I am a veteran who ran for Congress in Pennsylvania Congressional District 3 for about 4 months before resigning in a tough 3 way primary. I raised just over \$15,000 and paid every bill and filed all the correct paperwork upon resigning. Personally I cannot afford a lawyer and took personal debt in order to campaign for Congress. I find this lawsuit absurd, insulting, and extremely presumptuous. I believe in our political system but did not benefit in any way, shape, or form as described in the law suit. I hope that the FEC can understand that I am the little guy here and should not be targeted in what is a large scale conservative versus liberal ploy.
