**CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME  
TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT ACTION**

In consideration for the Federal Election Commission granting an extension to respond to the General Counsel's Brief in this matter, respondent Charlene Spears, hereby consents to extend the statute of limitations of any civil enforcement action that the Federal Election Commission might institute in connection with MUR 4818 pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(6), for twenty-two (22) days, or, if a lesser number of days, the number of days until the response brief is received. This action will extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement action in connection with MUR 4818 by the same period mentioned above from the expiration of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462, or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in this matter.

There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement action without the written consent of the respondent or her representative.
