On March 10, 2000, the Federal Election Commission notified Issa for Congress and you, as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On July 18, 2001, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, that there is no reason to believe Issa for Congress and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 441d(a). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter. A copy of the General Counsel's Report is enclosed for your information.


The confidentiality provisions at 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(12) no longer apply and this matter is now public. In addition, although the complete file must be placed on the public record within 30 days, this could occur at any time following certification of the Commission's vote. While the file may be placed on the public record before receiving your additional materials, any permissible submissions will be added to the public record upon receipt.
