This letter is to memorialize my telephone conversation with you on November 18, 1997. As discussed, this Office believes that certain information requested in the Interrogatories and Requests for Documents should not be particularly burdensome for your clients to produce back through 1984 instead of November 1992 as suggested in your letter dated November 6, 1997. Specifically, I referred to numbers 1 and 5 of the Interrogatories, number 5 of the Request for Documents, and numbers 2 and 6 of the Requests for Documents as they relate to any agreements, contracts, and/or documents which evidence the arrangement whereby China Airlines, Ltd. ("CAL") seconded and/or transferred employees to Longevity International Enterprises Corporation ("Longevity").

As your client's response to the subpoena and order are technically due on November 20, 1997 and this Office is required to negotiate subpoena compliance in a timely fashion, we hope to hear from you concerning the aforementioned issues by the close of business today. Also, this Office suggests that you file a request for an extension of time no later than the close of business on Friday, November 21, 1997.
