

1. *Chlorophyll a* (Chl a) is the primary photosynthetic pigment in most plants and algae. It is a green pigment that absorbs light energy in the blue and red regions of the visible spectrum.

2. *Chlorophyll b* (Chl b) is an accessory pigment found in green plants and algae. It absorbs light energy in the blue and red regions of the visible spectrum, similar to Chl a, but has a slightly different absorption spectrum.

3. *Carotenoids* are a group of pigments that include carotenes and xanthophylls. They are responsible for the yellow, orange, and red colors seen in autumn foliage. Carotenoids absorb light energy in the blue and blue-green regions of the visible spectrum.

4. *Xanthophylls* are a subset of carotenoids that are responsible for the yellow color seen in autumn foliage. They absorb light energy in the blue and blue-green regions of the visible spectrum.

5. *Anthocyanins* are water-soluble pigments that are responsible for the red, purple, and blue colors seen in autumn foliage. They are not true pigments in the same sense as the others, as they are not part of the photosynthetic apparatus.
