I. ACTIONS RECOMMENDED

II. BACKGROUND

On April 6, 2000, the Commission found reason to believe that the National Cotton Council Committee for the Advancement of Cotton and William R. Tracy, as treasurer ("Respondents" or "Committee"), violated 2 U.S.C. § 434 (a)(4)(A)(i) by failing to timely file their 1998 July Quarterly Report. The Commission also determined to enter into pre-probable cause conciliation and approved a conciliation agreement

III. DISCUSSION

A check for the civil penalty has not been received.

Based on the foregoing, this Office recommends that the Commission accept the attached agreement with National Cotton Council Committee for the Advancement of Cotton and William R. Tracy, as treasurer, and close the file in this matter.
