Dear Mr. Allen:

Following up on our conference call on Wednesday, November 17, 1999, involving you, Eric Brown, Jeff Parker and me, enclosed please find a copy of the Conciliation Agreement relating to the referenced matters "With Comments from Respondents dated 11/19/99" (my interlineations).

Several of those interlineations refer to the following discussions:

As to the contribution from the National Chamber Alliance for Politics (\$920.92 on October 23, 1998 and \$566.93 on November 3, 1998), please be advised that I followed up my voice mail messages of Tuesday, November 16, 1999, with another call to Pat Gartland of the U.S. Chamber of Commerce on Thursday, November 18, 1999. In the course of the latter discussion, I asked Mr. Gartland to send us a copy of any notification of these inkind contributions. I also reminded him that it was our clear understanding (confirmed by my campaign manager) to reimburse the Chamber for any expenses in connection with a reception they sponsored for our campaign on October 23, 1998. Mr. Gartland apologized for that

misunderstanding and told me that he would investigate the cause of the reporting of an inkind contribution rather than the billing of Inglis for Senate Committee, Inc., for amounts expended on our behalf.

As to the National Taxpayers Union Campaign Fund (\$1,160 on October 28, 1998), enclosed please find a copy of a fax to me from Al Cours, Jr., of the National Taxpayers Union Campaign Fund dated November 16, 1999, which attaches a copy of a letter to our campaign dated January 5, 1999 along with the envelope containing that January 5, 1999, letter which was returned to the National Taxpayers Union Campaign Fund.


As we discussed during the course of our conference call, we did not report this contribution because we had no knowledge of it. We intend to refund the National Taxpayers Union Campaign Fund in the amount of \$1,160, it being the recollection of our campaign manager that it was made clear that nothing the National Taxpayers Union Campaign Fund did on our behalf should constitute a direct or an inkind contribution.


