On February 15, 2000, the Federal Election Commission reviewed the allegations in your complaint dated December 7, 1998, and the responses thereto. Based on the information provided in your complaint, and the information provided by the American Postal Workers Union, AFL-CIO, the Commission determined that there is no reason to believe the aforementioned respondents violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision will follow.

The Act allows a complainant to seek judicial review of the Commission's dismissal of this action. See 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(8).
