Michael Poss, as treasurer; Perot '96, and J. Michael Poss, as treasurer; R. Clayton Mulford, Esquire; or Russell L. Verney violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 441a(a)(1), or 441a(a)(3). Accordingly, the Commission on December 28, 1998 closed its file in this matter.
