On November 1, 2004, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, Representative Neil Abercrombie, Abercrombie for Congress and Jack Y. Endo, in his official capacity as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). On February 8, 2006, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, and information provided by your clients, that there is no reason to believe your clients accepted contributions in violation of the Act or the Commission's regulations, as alleged in this matter. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.


