Dear Mr. Thomas:

This letter is in response to the Federal Election Commission's ("Commission") August 11, 2005 Notification with Factual and Legal Analysis for the above-referenced proceeding.

We do not challenge the Commission's allegation that Sandy Lyons for Congress and Melissa B. Jordan ("Jordan"), in her official capacity as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. §441a-1(b)(1)(C) and 11 C.F.R. § 400.21(b) and Sanford David "Sandy" Lyons ("Lyons") violated 2 U.S.C. §441a-1(b)(1)(C).

First, 2004 was the first federal election year after passage of the Bipartisan Campaign Reform Act of 2002. Accordingly, 2004 was the first time campaigns had to comply with the "Millionaire's Amendment" and the related new reporting requirements promulgated by the Commission. As indicated in Jordan's affidavit (enclosure 1), on July 9, 2005 she learned that Lyons had deposited an additional \$100,000 in the Sandy Lyons for Congress account on July 8, 2005. As soon as Jordan made this discovery, she completed FEC Form 10 and sent it via U.S. mail


to the Commission. At this time, Jordan believed that FEC Form 10 needed to be postmarked within 24 hours and did not realize it had to actually be received by the Commission within 24 hours. The Commission's file copy of the Sandy Lyons for Congress FEC Form 10 is date stamped July 14, 2005 and the attached "Envelope Replacement Page for Incoming Documents" indicates the envelope containing the FEC Form 10 was postmarked July 9, 2005 (see enclosure 2).

Second, the late filing of the FEC Form 10 by Jordan did not cause any actual harm to any other candidate. The FEC Form 10 was received by the Commission on July 14<sup>th</sup>, six days prior to the July 20<sup>th</sup> Republican primary. In addition, another candidate in the primary, George Moretz, had already triggered the Millionaire's Amendment. Finally, Lyons placed third in a four-way primary race and received only 19.6% of the vote.

For these reasons, it is our contention that this late filing was not willful and knowing and did not harm any of the other candidates involved in the primary. Mr. Lyons was a first time federal candidate and does not plan on running for federal office again.

**Affidavit of Melissa B. Jordan**

I, Melissa B. Jordan, upon my oath do state as follows:

1. I served as Treasurer of the Sandy Lyons for Congress campaign from January 15, 2004 to July 15, 2004.
2. On July 9, 2004, I learned Sandy Lyons had personally deposited an additional \$100,000 into the campaign account on July 8, 2004. I typed up the FEC Form 10 and sent the required disclosure via the U. S. Postal Service.
3. As of July 9, 2004, I was under the impression that FEC Form 10 only had to be postmarked within 24 hours of receipt of funds. I was unaware the law required that the FEC actually receive the disclosure form within 24 hours.
