Dear Ms. Goodson and Mr. Svoboda:

On February 2, 2006, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, Bob Filner for Congress, Congressman Bob Filner, Jane Filner, and Campaign Resources, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On July 13, 2006, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, information provided by you, and other publicly available information, that there is no reason to believe your clients violated 2 U.S.C. § 439a and 11 C.F.R. § 113.1(g). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.


